## Background

This memorandum accompanies the City of Baltimore Mayor's Office of Recovery Program's submission of its monthly report to the City Council on spending and performance related to American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding. Specifically, Council Bill 21-0121 § 49-2(B) prescribes the elements of legislatively required reporting, which stipulates that monthly reports should:

- 1) Provide data and metrics regarding how the funds have:
  - I. Increased the effectiveness of city government services;
  - II. Broadened the reach of city government services;
  - III. Made city government services more efficient;
  - IV. Made city government services more sustainable
  
- 2) Identify key performance indicators, benchmarks, and targets related to:
  - I. Equity, as defined in Article 1, § 39-1 of the Baltimore City Code;
  - II. Population Growth;
  - III. Labor and Employment;
  - IV. Economic Growth, especially the growth of minority and women-owned businesses;
  - and,
  - V. Community Benefit

## Commitments and Expenditures

Since the last report to City Council, total commitments have increased by \$14,385,000 which includes:

- \$13,085,000 through a third round of nonprofit awards
- \$2,100,000 for the creation of a Digital Services Team

On August 8, 2022, the City of Baltimore completed Phase II of Workday implementation, transitioning all financial transactions from multiple legacy systems into one modern, cloud-based application. The Recovery Office and other City agencies are working to review and validate data that migrated to Workday. Once this review has been completed and any notable questions or discrepancies addressed, the Recovery Office will resume submission of monthly and cumulative expenditure data to City Council.

The fiscal administrators of the Economic Recovery Fund (ERF) maintain accounting systems that are separate from the City's Workday financial system. Each month, the administrators are required to report to the Recovery Office on their spend-down of the portion of the Fund that they are administering. Accordingly, the ERF expenditures shown in the Appendix have been updated to include data through August.

### **Performance Measures and Metrics**

As previously noted, many agencies are still fully designing and implementing programs, therefore data are limited. Additional data on performance measures will be included in Council reports as programs are further implemented and data becomes available. The Recovery Office anticipates including some targets and benchmarks for agency performance during the FY23 period of performance. In the interim, the report includes narrative information on agency accomplishments to date. In addition, the Recovery Office is working with university partners and funded agencies and organizations in the coming months to establish equity-related targets based on best practices and available baseline data.

### *Population, Labor & Employment Growth*

Council legislation requires key performance indicators, benchmarks, and targets related to population growth. No data source exists that would demonstrate population growth on a monthly basis. In addition, some ARPA funding may be used for programs and initiatives that could result in population growth. However, such instances would be anecdotal in nature, and cannot be positively correlated to ARPA.

The Mayor's Office of Recovery Programs has awarded ARPA funding for significant investments into small businesses, and non-profits with a prioritization on minority and women-led organizations. As previously noted, data are limited as programs are being implemented. The results of efforts to date are included in the Economic Recovery Fund portion of the report.

The Mayor's Office of Recovery Programs continues to make significant progress in the awarding of ARPA funds, the monitoring of agency and organization's progress, and in the accountability and transparency in the use of these funds. # Commitments

# Recovery Office Accomplishments

Since the last report, the Mayor's Office of Recovery Programs announced its third round of funding commitments to 15 nonprofit organizations, totaling \$13,085,000 million:

- **Aequo Foundation will receive \$2,000,000** to support the redevelopment of vacant properties into affordable housing, leading to increased public safety, and remediate homes through the removal of lead and other health hazards.
- **Parity Baltimore Incorporated will receive \$700,000** to help prevent homelessness as well as wealth and land loss within Black, Indigenous, People of Color (BIPOC) communities. The SOS Fund, a joint collaboration between Fight Blight Bmore and Parity, offers beneficiaries assistance such as tax sale foreclosure prevention, ground rent redemption, homeowners tax credit application, mutual aid support, and many other resources.
- **Pro Bono Resource Center of Maryland will receive \$700,000** to provide counseling services, including housing counseling, and host mortgage prevention clinics designed to empower individuals and families to maintain and preserve homeownership,
- **ReBUILD Metro will receive \$1,250,000** to support affordable housing development in Johnston Square, including funding to develop abandoned and dilapidated properties within two blocks of 1100 Greenmount Avenue.
- **Rebuilding Together Baltimore, Inc. will receive \$575,000** to serve households who are physically and financially unable to make necessary health and safety repairs to their homes, helping to keep them in their homes, prevent blight, and stabilize neighborhoods that have been disproportionately impacted by COVID-19.
- **South Baltimore Community Land Trust (SBCLT) will receive \$450,000** to acquire and rehabilitate vacant homes into affordable housing for homebuyers in the Curtis Bay, Cherry Hill, and Brooklyn neighborhoods of South Baltimore.
- **Green & Healthy Homes Initiative Inc. will receive \$2,500,000** to fund home repairs for low-income Baltimore households to remediate lead hazards, asthma triggers, safety hazards, and energy loss.
- **Black Yield Institute will receive \$1,000,000** to support the development of an urban farm to include training and educational resources, and provide infrastructure, such as outdoor refrigeration and washing stations, to support food aggregation for city farms.
- **Leadenhall Baptist Church will receive \$200,000** to provide food and other non-perishables to the Sharp-Leadenhall Community with the goal of positively impacting and improving the health of the residents by addressing, mitigating, and alleviating food insecurity.
- **The B&O Railroad Museum, Inc. will receive \$185,000** to add green space to the B&O Railroad Museum's backyard, creating a valuable space for community members, guests, and Baltimore City school groups and enabling outdoor gatherings and space for social distancing to support COVID-19 mitigation.
- **No Boundaries Coalition Inc. will receive \$750,000** to provide youth income and workforce development opportunities that will improve civic engagement, increase employability, and strengthen personal and professional goals all while supplementing household income by providing an hourly wage/stipend to participants.
- **International Rescue Committee will receive \$325,000** to support workforce development programs focused on COVID-impacted low-income and Limited English Proficient (LEP) humanitarian immigrants who reside in Baltimore City. Services will connect clients to local jobs through assistance with resume building, interview

preparation, public transit orientation, and, for parents, access to childcare services and vouchers.


- **Banner Neighborhoods will receive \$950,000** to support the renovation of their Preston Street classroom space. ARPA funding will also support academic tutoring, mentoring, program facilitators, sports coaches, and other support staff dedicated to providing services to youth, including students experiencing psychological or behavioral difficulties.
- **Volo Kids Foundation will receive \$1,000,000** to support the operation of the BActive program, providing Baltimore kids with access to quality, structured sports programming in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. Sports clinics facilitated by BActive will teach lessons in communication, body positivity, and confidence-building through sports, with a focus on trauma-informed care. BActive will connect kids, particularly those in recreation deserts, with ongoing Baltimore City Recreation and Parks (BCRP) programming.
- **Southwest Partnership will receive \$500,000** to help renovate the Poppleton Recreation Center, enabling it to reopen as a safe space for recreation in the Poppleton neighborhood. Once renovated, the Center will provide programming for children and youth and offer space for senior programming.

## Subawardee Accomplishments

### Economic Recovery Fund

A total of 726 grants, totaling \$12,299,258 have been awarded from Economic Recovery Fund fiscal agents to beneficiaries to date, including nonprofits and small businesses (the full list of organizations is in the appendix). The map below indicates the location of all organizations funded through August 2022. Please note, some nonprofit organizations funded by BCF used their headquarters address on applications for funding. Though the location where services are rendered may not be specifically depicted in the map, sub-awardees provide services to a wide variety of neighborhoods across the City.

***Baltimore Civic Fund (BCF) Economic Recovery Assistance***

The Baltimore Civic Fund is in the process of completing payments for its second round of awards, the 2022 Nonprofit Relief Fund. BCF paid 17 nonprofits out of 119 awardees as a part of this round, and grantees were paid a total of \$416,221.98. BCF will continue making payments to the remaining 102 awardees, which will be included in future reports.

### *Baltimore Development Corporation (BDC) Economic Recovery Assistance*

BDC and the Recovery Office amended the grant agreement for this project to reduce the maximum award amount to \$25,000 to help increase the number of grant recipients. In addition, the agreement was amended to permit BDC to award Child Day Care service providers, and to change the established by date of the business to prior to January 1, 2021 to be eligible for funding.

Subsequently, BDC announced the opening of its second application window, which will close on Thursday, October 13, 2022. BDC also made payments to 27 businesses in August 2022 totaling \$279,715.50, the majority of which were second disbursements to grant recipients. The table below includes the grant recipient receiving its first disbursement only.

### *Visit Baltimore Economic Recovery Assistance*

Visit Baltimore is currently conducting its follow-up survey, which the Recovery Office plans to summarize and report next month.

### *Baltimore Office of Promotion and the Arts Recovery Assistance (BOPA)*

In August, BOPA administered payments to 23 additional artist recovery grantees. At the time of this report, BOPA has fulfilled payments for 110 out of 112 grantees and continues to coordinate with the remaining two grantees.

### *Family League Economic Recovery Assistance*

The Family League of Baltimore City has expended its \$2 million grant award and disbursed funds to 182 child day care providers. At the 6-month follow-up, with 91% of awardees responding, 90% of respondents said that the award funds helped them remain in business, and 89% reported that the funds helped them to better serve families.

# City Agencies Accomplishments

## *Baltimore City Recreation and Parks (BCRP)*

BCRP was awarded \$41 million to modernize the City's recreation and park facilities, including pools, recreations centers, playgrounds, athletic courts, and trails. The Greater Model pool has begun design while the Towanda and Coldstream pools are in design and are preparing to bid for construction. Design has begun for the Gardenville and Curtis Bay Recreation Centers, while BCRP is preparing the Parkview Recreation Center project to bid for construction. Finally, the Furley Recreation Center is also in design, and the Middle Branch Trail project is on the October 5, 2022 Board of Estimates agenda.

## *Baltimore City Health Department (BCHD)*

The Health Department is processing invoices that will allow them to fully move into the PPE warehouse funded by ARPA. Additionally, BCHD is continuing its recruitment efforts for its adult guardianship, Aging Nutrition Fellow, and Food Security Clinical Health Workers. Finally, BCHD is preparing for its Fall vaccine outreach campaign.

## *Broadband and Digital Equity (BDE)*

BDE within Baltimore City Information & Technology continues the transition of this project from the Mayor's Office and began detailed planning for a new initiative as part of the Phase II Broadband investment. BDE is collaborating with Baltimore City Recreation & Parks (BCRP) to plan and execute the effort to extend City fiber to all recreation centers not currently on the City's network. This includes coordinating construction schedules since BCRP also received a substantial ARPA capital award related to recreation centers. BDE is also collaborating with the Housing Authority of Baltimore City (HABC) to complete a public Wi-Fi pilot at Gilmore Homes.

## *Mayor's Office of Children and Family Success (MOCFS)*

Mayors for a Guaranteed Income, a national network of mayors who advocate for a Guaranteed Income - direct, recurring cash payments with no strings attached—published a new [dashboard](#) that shows how families are benefiting from these payments around the country. Spending data for Baltimore will be included within the next quarterly dashboard update after at least three months of data have been collected. Baltimore started disbursing monthly payments to approved program participants on August 15, 2022.

## *Mayor's Office of Homeless Services (MOHS)*

The Housing Navigation and Landlord Engagement project is in the beginning stages of project implementation. The Recovery Office is in the process of executing two inter-agency agreements: the Shelter Diversion and Rapid Resolution Fund and the Shelter Demobilization project and should be approved by the next monthly report.

## *Mayor's Office of Neighborhood Safety and Engagement (MONSE)*

MONSE continues to prepare agreements for Board of Estimates approval for previously announced awards. The Recovery Office has been engaged with MONSE for the Returning Citizens Behind the Wall Initiative in preparation for finalization. The Community Engagement and Opportunity team

updated its case management questions to accurately collect data points associated with the Coordinated Stabilization Response (CNSR) efforts. MONSE will collect 911, 211, and 311 data to inform the interagency and community-based organization response in communities that experience a qualifying activation event. In addition, MONSE will record data for all qualifying activation events and conduct pre- and post-surveys to record qualitative data for perceptions of safety with residents and school-aged youth. Lastly, MONSE recently onboarded two Data Analysts and one Gun Violence Victim Services Manager and continues to work towards fulfilling remaining vacancies.

### ***Mayor's Office of Employment Development (MOED)***

Eighteen Train Up Occupational Skills training providers continue to provide services, including 7 funded by the City ARPA allocation. In August, the final Community Connector contract was approved by BOE along with the Contract for Behavioral Health Services with Associated Catholic Charities. These are the final two agreements for ARPA programs.

A total of 259 participants enrolled in Train Up Occupational Skills Training, of which 104 are City ARPA-funded. A total of 75 enrollees have obtained certifications, 31 have completed their training, and 7 have gained employment with an average wage of \$20.86 (includes City and State ARPA funded programs). Most training completers are still in their job search phase, and more placements are expected by next month.

Funding for the Hire Up program has shifted to the City ARPA allocation. As of August 31, 141 unemployed/underemployed Baltimore City residents have received subsidized employment through Hire Up. Of the employed, 22 are funded by the City ARPA allocation. Currently, worksites include: MOED, the Baltimore City Department of Transportation, Department of Finance, Baltimore City Recreation and Parks Department, Department of Public Works, Parking Authority of Baltimore City, Downtown Partnership of Baltimore, and the Mayor's Office of African American Male Engagement, which also operates another worksite, The Food Project.

Hire Up and Train Up Project Managers continue to coordinate with two legal services providers, Maryland Legal Aid and Maryland Volunteer Lawyers Service. BOE approval was granted in August for the sub-agreement with Associated Catholic Charities to provide behavioral health services for Train Up and Hire Up participants and these services are being offered.

Through the Small Business Wage Subsidy, a total of 263 unemployed or underemployed residents have been hired at small, minority- or woman-owned businesses, and 169 subsidies have been paid to businesses thus far (paid upon 10 weeks of employment). Approximately 122 of these subsidies are supported by the City ARPA allocation. About 96% of hires have remained in their positions after 10 weeks of employment.

YouthWorks made offers to 6,761 youth for five-week jobs running from July 5 through August 5, 2022. Based on post-program survey results, 90% of youth workers expressed a positive experience and 89% reported an increase in job readiness due to YouthWorks.

The Let's Ride to Work Program, in partnership with Lyft, provides up to 40 rides for newly hired employees working in Baltimore City. As of August 2022, 51 clients received a total of 959 rides.

### ***Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD)/Housing***

DHCD's Impact Investment Area Neighborhood Relief Fund (IIANRF) is in the beginning stages of project implementation. Additionally, DHCD and Live Baltimore Home Center, Inc. have partnered to provide additional funding to Baltimore City residents who have been impacted by

COVID-19 for down payment assistance. The program will aid in efforts to stabilize Baltimore City’s population, retain residents, support fragile neighborhood housing markets, improve affordable housing stock, increase homeownership rates, reduce the racial wealth gap, as well as preventing renter displacement. The grant agreement is currently in development.

HABC’s PSO Infrastructure project is in the beginning stages of project implementation. The PSO Transformation Plan’s grant agreement is currently in development.

### Department of Planning (DOP)

The grant application period for the Clean Corps initiative opened on August 15. DOP promoted the grant opportunity through social media, newsletters and emails to agency contact lists. DOP also hosted three Information Sessions about the Clean Corps grant and selected a team for review and selection of the submitted applications.
