BACKGROUND

This memorandum accompanies the City of Baltimore Mayor's Office of Recovery Program's submission of its monthly report to the City Council on spending and performance related to American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding. Specifically, Council Bill 21-0121 § 49-2(B) prescribes the elements of legislatively required reporting, which stipulates that monthly reports should:

1. Provide data and metrics regarding how the funds have:
 - I. Increased the effectiveness of city government services;
 - II. Broadened the reach of city government services;
 - III. Made city government services more efficient;
 - IV. Made city government services more sustainable

2. Identify key performance indicators, benchmarks, and targets related to:
 - I. Equity, as defined in Article 1, § 39-1 of the Baltimore City Code;
 - II. Population Growth;
 - III. Labor and Employment;
 - IV. Economic Growth, especially the growth of minority and women-owned businesses; and,
 - V. Community Benefit

COMMITMENTS AND EXPENDITURES

At the end of May, the Mayor's Office of Recovery Programs committed \$641.1 million in ARPA funds to City agencies, quasi-governmental organizations, and nonprofits to advance priority initiatives for Baltimore City residents. By July 2024, about \$302.8 million had been spent on ARPA-funded projects (See Table 1), accounting for about 47% of the current commitments and the city's \$641M total ARPA allocation.

Commitments

Table 1 lists ARPA commitments totaling \$641,170,126 and expenditures totaling \$302,833,887 through July 2024.

Recovery Office Accomplishments

The Mayor's Office of Recovery Programs awarded ARPA funding to 45 nonprofit organizations. As of July 2024, all 45 nonprofits have received disbursements totaling \$31.1 million. See Table 1 for total disbursements. In addition, some highlights of select nonprofit activities in July are as follows:

- Greater Baltimore Urban League's Workforce Development Security + certification program began on July 15th. Nine individuals are presently enrolled. The goal is to provide these participants with a comprehensive skill set encompassing both the basics of IT and the knowledge associated with a more in-depth area of cybersecurity.
- The Pennsylvania Avenue Black Arts and Entertainment District held its youth-specific recurring networking event, which drew a record number of youth, with 48 youth attending this month's iteration of the event. The organization is also planning its annual Black Artist Fair, which will connect 300-500 creatives to resources and training opportunities.
- ReBUILD Metro held its groundbreaking ceremony for Greenmount Park Apartments. Project construction has begun, including significant grading and site infrastructure.

In addition, the Recovery Office continues to provide technical assistance to all funded city agencies, quasi-government agencies, and nonprofits and coordinates with centralized functions such as legal, procurement, and finance to facilitate timely disbursements and expenditures.

SUBAWARDEE ACCOMPLISHMENTS

ECONOMIC RECOVERY FUND

Economic Recovery Fund (ERF) fiscal agents have awarded 1,068 grants to beneficiaries, totaling \$20,078,696, including nonprofits and small businesses (See Appendix for a complete list of

organizations). Four out of five fiscal agents have completed their grant programs. The fifth fiscal agent—Baltimore Development Corporation (BDC)—has finished disbursing grants to its sub-recipients and is collecting required documentation from beneficiaries in order to close its grant program. The table below outlines the demographic makeup of ERF beneficiaries broken down by fiscal agent, including the percent that are located in a Qualified Census Tract, and the percent of organizations led by minorities and/or women. A map of Economic Recovery Fund recipients can be found on the Recovery Office dashboard.

BALTIMORE DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION (BDC) ECONOMIC RECOVERY ASSISTANCE

As of the end of June 2024, BDC has paid 464 businesses, thereby completing all payments to small businesses as a part of the Economic Recovery Fund. BDC has also paid all technical assistance (TA) partners now that their work is complete. The Recovery Office and BDC are currently going through the grant closeout process to ensure that all required documentation from small business awardees has been received following their final payments.

CITY AGENCY ACCOMPLISHMENTS

BALTIMORE CITY RECREATION AND PARKS (BCRP)

RECREATION CENTERS

A notice to proceed (NTP) was issued to the contractor on July 1, 2024, followed by site clearing and grading work for the Gardenville Recreation Center. The Elijah Cummings Recreation Center project, formerly referred to as the South Baltimore Recreation Center, is still soliciting bidders, with bids due on September 18, 2024.

POOLS

The Towanda and Coldstream pool projects have begun, with the contractor making significant progress in demolishing the original infrastructure,

putting in forms, and pouring concrete. Both projects are on track for completion by the next swim season. The Greater Model pool project solicitation will end on August 7th. BCRP is targeting awarding the contract in September 2024.

ATHLETIC COURTS

The two remaining Athletic Court resurfacing projects, Evesham and Briscoe Park, have begun, and are on track for timely completion.

PLAYGROUNDS

BCRP completed the following six playground projects in June: Patterson Park – Linwood Ave., Pimlico, Bonview, Clifton, Silverbell, and Roosevelt. BCRP completed an additional three playground projects in July: Edgewood Lyndhurst, Morrell Park, and Lake Montebello (renamed the Mary Pat Clarke Playground). Five of the remaining six playground projects will be completed by the end of this year, while the last playground project, Dewees, will be completed next year, due to delays in ordering the playground equipment.

TRAILS

The Gwynns Falls Trail wayfinding signage project has continued to experience delays in the award process, and BCRP is coordinating with the Bureau of Procurement and the Mayor’s Office of Small and Minority Business Advocacy and Development to address outstanding issues in order to move forward with the award.

BALTIMORE CITY HEALTH DEPARTMENT (BCHD)

As of the end of June 2024, BCHD officially disbanded the COVID-19 case investigation program. Funding for the COVID-19 staff ended on June 28, 2024. Currently, there are no ARPA-funded activities in case of outbreak investigations.

BCHD’s Communications vendor is developing and editing new ads to align with a back-to-school vaccination campaign.

BCHD recently received a shipment of 4,000 test kits to distribute to its partners and Pratt Library locations. The agency is working to procure an additional 40,000 at-home COVID-19 test kits for the Fall.

The Vaccination team continues to provide community-based vaccine clinics throughout Baltimore City and home visits for City residents in need of COVID-19 vaccination. Community mobile clinic activity will wind down during August and BCHD is preparing for the Fall season of 2024-25 COVID-19 and Flu vaccinations. In July, the VALUE Communities (VC) team organized and led 18 engagement events in senior residences, health centers, community centers, churches, schools, Judy centers, universities, markets, and recreational centers. The nature of such events is to provide education on COVID-19 vaccination and testing, listen to Baltimore City residents’ medical and social needs, and provide various resources that link clients to services. The type of outreach includes setting up

information tables at health, wellness, and resource fairs, clinics, food and diaper distribution sites, back-to-school events, and school and planning meetings. The VC team has planned 35 more similar engagement events in the coming months.

The BCHD food insecurity team is working with the Law Department to compile food contract amendments through December 2025. The RFP for the congregate meal program has been submitted to procurement to put it out to bid. The IFB for the home-delivered food boxes is being re-posted, and submissions are due in August. BCHD plans to expand its SNAP outreach to reach older Spanish-speaking residents. For example, Maryland Hunger Solutions is partnering with BCHD to provide a SNAP outreach session in Spanish.

BALTIMORE CITY INFORMATION & TECHNOLOGY (BCIT)

HARDWARE REFRESH, CITIWATCH, AND HYBRID MEETING ROOM

BCIT has refreshed 209 PCs through July 2024 and has upgraded 12 meeting rooms with hybrid capabilities. The team is currently on schedule and will outfit an additional 5-7 rooms and mobile solutions. The next group of rooms is scheduled for completion in September. In addition, BCIT has encumbered an additional \$1.2M in preparation for refreshing computer devices.

BCIT has purchased all hardware needed to improve the CitiWatch infrastructure planned under this grant, with installations occurring by the end of the calendar year.

BROADBAND AND DIGITAL EQUITY (BDE)

DIGITAL EQUITY FUND

BCIT is in the panel review stage of Digital Equity Fund (DEF) Cycle II, where they evaluate and select the most promising proposals. Fifty-one applications, representing 35 organizations, have been received across various grant tiers, to include:

- Digital Literacy for Older Adults: 16 applications
- Digital Literacy for Tech Hubs: 10 applications
- Advanced Digital Education/IT Fundamentals: 12 applications
- Digital Creatives: 13 applications

PUBLIC WI-FI

The BCIT-BDE team has successfully connected 46 recreation centers to the free public wi-fi network, FreeBmoreWiFi, providing indoor wi-fi access at all locations and outdoor wi-fi access at nearly all. This is a major milestone in the deployment of public wi-fi through ARPA. BCIT-BDE has also connected 3 senior centers to the FreeBmoreWiFi, with plans for more.

ACCESS TO MODERN DEVICES

- **Chromebook Distribution:** During July, BCIT continued its efforts to expand digital access by distributing Chromebooks to individuals in need. As of August 9, 2024, BCIT had successfully distributed 33,693 Chromebooks.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT AND ADVOCACY

- **East Baltimore Digital Equity Initiative:** BCIT actively participated in this collaborative effort, bringing together institutions and community-based organizations to work on a proposal for the Digital Equity Act's Competitive Grant Program. This initiative addresses the digital divide in Baltimore, ensuring that underrepresented communities gain access to necessary digital resources and opportunities.
- **Technical Assistance and Support:** BCIT provided crucial technical assistance and support to five community-based and faith-based organizations. BCIT's efforts helped these organizations expand their inclusion initiatives, enabling them to support homebound individuals and out-of-state participants better, ensuring no one is left behind in the digital age.
- **Rebuild Johnson Square Computer Lab:** BCIT offered financial and technical support for the ribbon cutting of the Johnson Square Computer Lab. This facility will serve as a vital resource for community members, offering access to technology and digital literacy programs to empower residents with the skills needed to thrive in a digital world.
- **NAACP National Convention Presentation:** BCIT presented at the National NAACP Convention in Las Vegas, Nevada, where we shared insights on community engagement and our ongoing efforts to foster inclusion within the

digital ecosystem. The team's presentation to the Maryland State Conference of the NAACP highlighted the importance of digital equity as a key component of broader civil rights efforts.

- **Maryland State Conference of the NAACP's Rural-Urban Digital Coalition:** BCIT facilitated a strategic meeting of this coalition, where plans were laid out for two upcoming panel discussions to be held during the NAACP Maryland State Conference in October 2024. These discussions will focus on bridging the digital divide between rural and urban communities, ensuring that all areas receive the attention and resources needed to achieve digital equity.

These efforts reflect BCIT's commitment to enhancing digital inclusion and equity, ensuring all community members can access the tools and resources necessary for success.

MAYOR'S OFFICE OF HOMELESS SERVICES (MOHS)

MOHS continues to make progress in implementing ARPA-funded programs.

- The rapid rehousing portion of the Shelter Demobilization grant will end by October 1, 2024. Approximately 114 residents have been housed through this program as of June 30, 2024. Numbers for July 31, 2024, are still being finalized as of the writing of this report.
- The Rapid Resolution and Shelter Diversion Fund will end by October 1, 2024. Approximately 159 residents have received assistance, including eviction prevention, through this fund as of July 31, 2024.
- Three Housing Accelerator Fund grants are slated for Board of Estimates approval in September 2024. Negotiations and grant agreement preparations are in the final stages for the other six grantees.
- Housing Navigators funded through the Housing Navigation and Landlord Engagement grant continue to provide assistance at library branches. Housing Identification Specialists are working to recruit landlords to the incentive program

and match people experiencing homelessness to those housing opportunities.

- ARPA funds are supporting costs at the two City-owned hotels operating as emergency shelters through the Shelter Acquisition and Operations grant. These funds are also supporting renovations at the Weinberg Housing and Resource Center (WHRC), the City's largest overnight emergency shelter.

MAYOR'S OFFICE OF NEIGHBORHOOD SAFETY AND ENGAGEMENT (MONSE)

VICTIM SERVICES (VS)

MONSE commenced its intensive case management program with the Mayor's Office of Children and Family Success (MOCFS), holding the first meetings on July 9th and July 23rd. These meetings were conducted with the Baltimore City Public School System, the Health Department, the Department of Social Services, the Police Department, and Juvenile Services.

COMMUNITY VIOLENCE INTERVENTION (CVI)

The following ARPA-funded Safe Streets events took place in July:

- Safe Streets Brooklyn Field Day Safe Summer
- Safe Streets Sandtown and Sandtown Winchester Community Collective Music in the Park
- Safe Streets Cherry Hill Safe Summer
- CVI network meeting
- Brooklyn Healing and Wellness event
- Mayor Scott's Rock the Block engagement events (Cherry Hill, Sandtown, and Penn North)

Lastly, Catholic Charities is expanding its CVI work by including city-wide violence prevention coordinators. These coordinators will connect high-risk individuals with resources, host events, and identify potential conflicts, including those that may arise from behind the wall.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT & OPPORTUNITY (CE&O)

MONSE is working with the data team to complete a user-friendly dashboard for Neighborhood Policing Plan (NPP) and Coordinated Neighborhood Stabilization Response (CNSR) initiatives. The University of Baltimore and the Baltimore Police Department (BPD) have reviewed the dashboard, which will be shared with the community in the coming months. The Peace Mobile attended the Mayor's Rock the Block event on July 18th to promote community peace and engagement. Also, MONSE organized a Youth Engagement Pool Party on July 19th to engage and connect with the community's youth.

The North Avenue & Hilton Street Business and Community Task Force, Inc. Began its Neighborhood Policing Plan operations on July 20th. The CNSR team activated on July 21st for a stabilization response at 509 North Kenwood Ave, followed by canvassing and safety walks.

GROUP VIOLENCE REDUCTION STRATEGY (GVRS)

YAP onboarded its new director, who will begin working with the organization in September. The GVRS expansion to the Southern District is still targeted for September/October 2024, pending resource coordination with BPD. MONSE is also continuing to work with other GVRS Districts as expansion activities continue.

SUBSIDIZED EMPLOYMENT

Mayor Scott was featured as a guest speaker at an event for the Returning Citizens Behind the Wall program on July 26th. The Secretary of the Maryland Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services (DPSCS) said Mayor Scott is the first Baltimore mayor to speak "Behind the Wall" with people preparing to return home from incarceration. The GVRS Transitional Employment program, a collaboration with MOED's HireUP program, has five current participants, and the MONSE team is working to finalize an interagency agreement with the Department of Planning to add GVRS participants to its Clean Corps program.

MAYOR'S OFFICE OF IMMIGRANT AFFAIRS (MIMA)

BALTIMORE NEW AMERICANS ACCESS COALITION (BNAAC)

As of May 31, 2024—the enrollment end date for the program—BNAAC concluded enrollment with a final number of 731 cases (667 family cases and 64 individual cases). Implementing partners continue to work with cases to ensure successful access to public benefits. To date, BNAAC has closed 512 cases of the 731 enrolled. Global Refuge is conducting monitoring of Community-Based Organizations (CBO) caseloads, including case file review and client interviews. Feedback to CBOs will be shared through the monitoring work and review of data dashboards. In August, MIMA and Global Refuge will begin biweekly one-on-one calls with CBOs to monitor case closures and database action steps' completion closely. These calls will provide individualized feedback and guidance to ensure each CBO stays on track to meet performance measures. CBOs continue to connect open cases to public benefits and other community resources, including assistance with Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) redetermination submissions and referrals to low-cost dental services and plans.

In July, Information and resource sharing occurred at Block parties in Cherry Hill and Belair Edison, the Baltimore Caribbean Carnival, and the Mayor's pop-up at Save a Lot in the neighborhoods of Fallstaff and Clifton. In the next month, outreach tabling and resource sharing will continue at back-to-school events in the neighborhoods of Brooklyn, Curtis Bay, and Moravia Park, as well as the Mayor's back-to-school event and Mayor's block parties in the neighborhoods of Frankford and Highlandtown

The outreach manager began to develop a qualitative analysis of the BNAAC project, developing questions and research scope. An independent reviewer from the University of Delaware School of Health Behavior Science provided feedback and approved the project to move into the execution phase. In August, the qualitative analysis will move into the interviewing phase.

LANGUAGE ACCESS

On July 1, MIMA announced the launch of General Language Access training for City employees using Workday. To accommodate employees who do not use Workday (such as contractual employees), on July 24, MIMA announced the availability of an alternative training method using MS Forms. By July 31, nearly half of the language access liaisons completed language access training. Both training options can be accessed on the Language Access Program SharePoint site. MIMA will continue to monitor and track staff training with the help of the Department of Human Resources and support agency liaisons as they identify colleagues in their respective agencies who will receive the training.

Also, in July, MIMA received interpretation equipment. The equipment will facilitate interpretation in up to 6 different languages at a single event or one language in up to 6 events happening simultaneously. MIMA will take inventory of the interpretation equipment in August and expects to make it available for city agencies to use for events, meetings, and other functions to facilitate communication with Limited English Proficiency (LEP) residents in late August or early September.

In mid-July, MIMA held office hours to answer any specific questions from liaisons developing language access plans, working on submissions of vital documents for translation, and other language access planning questions. Office hours in July took place on:

- Wednesday, 7/10
- Thursday, 7/11
- Thursday, 7/18
- Thursday, 7/25

On July 29, MIMA announced the availability of the LanguageLine mobile app and launched updated guidance on using the mobile app or phone line. The updated guidance includes a digital copy of LanguageLine's Language Identification card, which agencies can show to an LEP individual so they can point to their language.

By the end of July, over half of the City agencies in Cohort 3 had submitted a draft of their agency's language access plans. MIMA will provide those agencies with feedback on their draft plans in early August.

In July, MIMA participated in the Brooklyn Healing Day led by MONSE and MOCFS and provided a language access briefing for the Summer Youth Engagement Team, which included a demonstration of the LanguageLine mobile app. MIMA will present language access updates at MIMA's Community Stakeholders Call on August 23. MIMA will present its language access program and work to reduce barriers for LEPs to City services and programs to Spanish-speaking/dominant families whose children are enrolled in Baltimore City Public Schools. The next Language Access Oversight Committee meeting will be on Wednesday, August 28.

DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT (DHCD)

WEALTH BUILDING

In the last reporting period, Wealth Building for Middle Neighborhoods has 571 cases in queue and 62 cases that have been identified to receive Wealth Building ARPA Grants.

TIVOLY ECO VILLAGE

The Tivoly Eco Village project is hoping to receive a release of funds approval from HUD in the early part of August. Receiving this will allow DHCD and partners the ability to develop budgets and finalize an existing Land Disposition Agreement (LDA). The project is targeting October for BOE submission.

IMPACT INVESTMENT AREAS (IIA)

The Impact Investment Area fund has had a number of notable successes this past reporting cycle. The Department of Housing and Community Development were able to stabilize the historic 1313 Druid Hill Avenue, which has garnered interest by developers. The Developer Incentives program has awarded approximately two million dollars in grants to developers to facilitate numerous affordable housing projects within the IIA's. Throughout the seven IIA neighborhoods, over 75 properties have been stabilized, and 69 properties are undergoing the initiation of acquisition via condemnation.

BALTIMORE SHINES

The Baltimore Shines project has been able to refer approximately 770 residents to other housing and utility bill resources. There have been 17 solar installs for residents bringing the total to 31 residents since the launch of the program. In addition to solar installs, 1,196 residents have participated in educational programs through community-based outreach.

PERMITTING SYSTEM UPGRADES

The Permitting System Upgrade project continues to meet weekly with internal stakeholders and Acela Project Managers to complete the refine and development stages of the many features of the new system. The target for going live remains the end of the calendar year.

DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING (DOP)

MIDDLE NEIGHBORHOODS CDC

Healthy Neighborhoods, Inc (HNI) successfully connected with the Fort Worthington/Berea Community Association (FWCA) and collaborated to create a survey for seniors about their programming interests. The association distributed the survey at its July community meeting to identify potential collaborations. In addition, HNI had an introductory conversation with the 6th Branch, a veteran-led service organization with extensive experience stewarding green space and supporting other groups, about a possible partnership with FWCA to maintain city-owned green space.

ONLINE SNAP

The Online SNAP team successfully contracted with Urban One and launched a radio ad campaign to increase awareness and incentive redemption for B'more Fresh. Additionally, the team is working with Amazon and Safeway to cover delivery fees for participants.

PRODUCE BOXES

DOP met with partners at the Maryland Food Bank (MFB) to discuss how they can support residents after the program ends. MFB discussed contacting sites directly to establish a connection and discuss procurement options.

CLEAN CORPS

Clean Corps significantly contributed to the Mayor's Spring Sprint, covering the entire active Clean Corps vacant lot selection three weeks before the July 27 deadline. Civicworks has expanded its workforce development services, providing information sessions on welding, drone operating, construction, and other fields of interest. Clean Corps has also launched a service-learning partnership with Forest Park High School, the first of several partnerships with schools in Clean Corps neighborhoods to engage students.

DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES (DGS)

BALTIMORE POLICE DEPARTMENT (BPD) FLEET

DGS has received 50 of the BPD Police Interceptor Utilities (PIUs) ordered using ARPA funds. The remaining 50 BPD PIUs are estimated to be delivered in September 2024. The 50 vehicles received have been upfitted, and 38 are now in service.

DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS (DPW) LOAD PACKERS

DGS fleet has received all 20 ARPA-funded load packers. All 20 units have been upfitted, tagged, and labeled and are now in service.

HVAC IMPROVEMENTS AT CITY LIBRARIES

Design work is underway for the six library branches receiving HVAC repair and replacement. At this time, DGS expects that construction at the Brooklyn and Northwood libraries will be completed first. Construction for all six libraries is expected to conclude by October 2025.

CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS

Construction for the Northwest Community Action Center project is underway. DGS has placed signage at the Center informing building users and visitors about the ongoing roof and storefront replacement project. Work is expected to be completed in October 2024.

DGS is currently working to procure a City Hall Roof project contract.

Two interagency agreements were executed with DGS to carry out facility improvements at Baltimore City Fire Stations. These include roof replacements, bathroom renovations, and other facility upgrades. DGS has amended and procured all contracts to carry out these improvements. Construction is expected to start shortly for facility upgrades, and roof replacements are slated to be completed by December 2024.

DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS (DPW)

WASTE REMOVAL

DPW is utilizing \$3,285,000 in ARPA funding to cover a contract for Spindler Refuse Service, Inc. to provide residential trash and recycling hauling for one year to help return to weekly recycling services.

RECYCLING CREWS

All 30 ARPA-funded recycling crew positions (10 solid waste drivers and 20 solid waste workers) were hired in January. These roles experience elevated turnover rates across the industry, a trend that similarly impacts DPW. As of July, one driver position reopened, and DPW is working to fill it promptly.

CAPITAL AND OPERATING IMPROVEMENTS

DPW will utilize ARPA funds for capital and operating improvements at select facilities. Operating improvements include purchasing new technology and larger equipment, including mini-load packers, tractors, and bobcats. DPW is currently working to amend existing contracts to include specific ARPA language. Capital improvement work should commence shortly. A portion of the vehicle purchases have already been ordered and spend down will occur as vehicles are delivered.

BALTIMORE CITY FIRE DEPARTMENT (BCFD)

BCFD is utilizing ARPA funding for the strategic acquisition of life-saving equipment. The equipment includes self-contained breathing apparatuses, thermal imaging cameras, hose replacements, and rain hoods. In addition to the two capital projects overseen by DGS, BCFD is currently in the process

of amending and procuring contracts for equipment purchases.

DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (DOT)

BCDOT has begun construction on its Citywide ADA contract with 30 ramps constructed through July 2024. BCDOT conducts inspection and verification of ADA ramp compliance before a ramp can be considered “completed.” The Notice to Proceed (NTP) for the ADA East contract is set for August, and the NTP for the ADA West contract will be in September. The Sidewalk Repair contract is still in the construction award process.

BALTIMORE CITY PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM (BCPSS)

BCPSS did not provide a status update for the July 2024 reporting period.

Performance Measures and Metrics

Table 3 includes a select number of performance measures. Measures should not be viewed as underperforming since many programs or data collection are just beginning. The Recovery Office will continue to coordinate with sub-recipients on measure accuracy. Additional data on performance measures will be included in Council reports as programs are further implemented and data becomes available.
