Re: American Rescue Plan Funds – Performance Oversight Council Bill 21-0121 Monthly Report

BACKGROUND

This memorandum accompanies the City of Baltimore Mayor's Office of Recovery Program's submission of its monthly report to the City Council on spending and performance related to American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding. Specifically, Council Bill 21-0121 § 49-2(B) prescribes the elements of legislatively required reporting, which stipulates that monthly reports should:

1. Provide data and metrics regarding how the funds have:
 - I. Increased the effectiveness of city government services;
 - II. Broadened the reach of city government services;
 - III. Made city government services more efficient;
 - IV. Made city government services more sustainable

2. Identify key performance indicators, benchmarks, and targets related to:
 - I. Equity, as defined in Article 1, § 39-1 of the Baltimore City Code;
 - II. Population Growth;
 - III. Labor and Employment;
 - IV. Economic Growth, especially the growth of minority and women-owned businesses; and,
 - V. Community Benefit

COMMITMENTS AND EXPENDITURES

At the end of August, the Mayor's Office of Recovery Programs committed \$641.1 million in ARPA funds to City agencies, quasi-governmental organizations, and nonprofits to advance priority initiatives for Baltimore City residents. Through August 2024, about \$316.1 million had been spent on ARPA-funded projects (See Table 1), accounting for about 47% of the current commitments and the city's \$641M total ARPA allocation.

Commitments

Table 1 lists ARPA commitments totaling \$641,170,126 and expenditures totaling \$316,147,056 through August 2024.

Notes: Commitment and expenditure data are through August 2024. "Pending projects" denotes financial commitments for projects that do not yet have a finalized budget. Contingency denotes funds set aside for unanticipated project costs.

Recovery Office Accomplishments

The Mayor's Office of Recovery Programs awarded ARPA funding to 45 nonprofit organizations. As of August 2024, all 45 nonprofits have received disbursements totaling \$32.0 million. See Table 1 for total disbursements. In addition, some highlights of select nonprofit activities in August are as follows:

- B360 celebrated the end of their most successful summer camp, reaching more attendees than any previous year.
- Parity Baltimore x the SOS Fund attended National Night Out and distributed over 50 backpacks to Robert Coleman Elementary School, each containing information for parents on the services provided by the SOS Fund.
- Project PLASE started construction at the temporary relocation site to better accommodate Project PLASE's needs while Beacon House Square is undergoing renovations.

In addition, the Recovery Office continues to provide technical assistance to all funded city agencies, quasi-government agencies, and nonprofits and coordinates with centralized functions such as legal, procurement, and finance to facilitate timely disbursements and expenditures.

SUBAWARDEE ACCOMPLISHMENTS

ECONOMIC RECOVERY FUND

Economic Recovery Fund (ERF) fiscal agents have awarded 1,068 grants to beneficiaries, totaling \$20,078,696, including nonprofits and small businesses (See Appendix for a complete list of organizations). Four out of five fiscal agents have completed their grant programs. The fifth fiscal agent—Baltimore Development Corporation (BDC)—has finished disbursing grants to its subrecipients and is collecting required documentation from beneficiaries in order to close its grant program. Accordingly, there will be no additional reporting on the ERF beginning as of October 2024.

The table below outlines the demographic makeup of ERF beneficiaries broken down by fiscal agent, including the percent located in a Qualified Census Tract and the percent of organizations led by minorities and/or women. A map of Economic Recovery Fund recipients can be found on the Recovery Office dashboard.

BALTIMORE DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION (BDC) ECONOMIC RECOVERY ASSISTANCE

BDC has completed all payments to small businesses and technical assistance (TA) partners as a part of the Economic Recovery Fund. The Recovery Office and BDC are currently going through the grant closeout process to ensure that all required documentation from small business awardees has been received following their final payments.

CITY AGENCY ACCOMPLISHMENTS

BALTIMORE CITY RECREATION AND PARKS (BCRP)

RECREATION CENTERS

Work on the Gardenville Recreation Center is ongoing, with substantial progress on on-site utilities and excavation for building foundations. The Elijah Cummings Recreation Center project, formerly referred to as the South Baltimore Recreation Center, is still soliciting bidders, with bids due on October 2, 2024.

POOLS

The Towanda and Coldstream pool projects are underway. Utilities are being installed, and excavation of the pools has been completed. The next step is forming a structure ahead of concrete pouring. Both projects are on track for completion by the next swim season. A compliant bid for the Greater Model Pool was received on August 7th. BCRP is now processing the contract award for October 2nd.

ATHLETIC COURTS

The Briscoe Park basketball court is complete. The Evesham basketball court will begin construction in September 2024.

PLAYGROUNDS

BCRP completed three playground projects in July: Edgewood Lyndhurst, Morrell Park, and Lake Montebello (renamed the Mary Pat Clarke Playground). Five of the remaining six playground projects will be completed by the end of this year, while the last playground project, Dewees, will be completed next year due to playground equipment purchasing delays.

TRAILS

The Gwynns Falls Trail wayfinding signage project is experiencing delays in the award process, and BCRP is coordinating with the Bureau of Procurement and the Mayor’s Office of Small and Minority Business Advocacy and Development to address outstanding issues in order to move forward with the award.

BALTIMORE CITY HEALTH DEPARTMENT (BCHD)

TESTING

BCHD received 47,808 COVID-19 Over-The-Counter kits at the end of August and is supporting distribution at local Enoch Pratt libraries. The Division of Aging picks up test kits, masks, and sanitizer to begin distribution to older adults at senior centers across the city.

COMMUNICATIONS

The BCHD Communications team and its vendor developed a new back-to-school vaccination ad

currently on television, radio, and digital that will air for two weeks. The team also updated a previously produced vaccination ad which is currently on television, radio, and digital that will air for three weeks. The team drafted a press release to announce that the Health Department is receiving the updated COVID-19 vaccine and will be holding new vaccination clinics. BCHD also updated previously produced graphics to use on social media. Additionally, BCHD worked with a reporter on a story regarding an increase in COVID-19 cases and worked with Johns Hopkins on producing a short video for social media, encouraging COVID-19 vaccination. BCHD has obtained 3,608,092 impressions on Facebook and Instagram and reached 1.1M separate accounts. On YouTube, the BCHD account obtained 600,344 impressions.

VACCINATION

On August 22, 2024, the 2024-2025 COVID-19 Vaccine Formula vaccine was authorized and the 2023-2024 COVID Vaccine Formula was retired. Since this announcement, COVID-19 clinics were paused the last two weeks of August 2024 until the new, 2024-2025 COVID-19 vaccine formula became available. In August, nine vaccination clinics were held delivering 87 doses of COVID-19 vaccine. In the month of August, the VALUE Communities team organized and led 35 engagement events in senior residences, health centers, community centers, churches, schools, Judy centers, universities, markets, and recreational centers. The nature of such events is to provide education on COVID-19 vaccination and testing, listen to Baltimore City

residents' medical and social needs and provide a variety of resources that link clients to services. Outreach efforts also include hosting information tables at health, wellness, and resource fairs, clinics, food and diaper distribution sites, back to school events, and school and planning meetings.

FOOD INSECURITY

BCHD is actively working with the Law Department to amend its food contracts. The Request for Proposal for the congregate meal program has been submitted to procurement to put out to bid. The pre-bid meeting for potential vendors is scheduled for September 18th. The Invitation for Bid (IFB) for home delivered food boxes has closed and responses will be reviewed with a goal of selecting a new vendor to start the program on November 1st. BCHD is working with partners to understand the impact of the closure of Benefits Data Trust (BDT) on SNAP application processing.

BALTIMORE CITY INFORMATION & TECHNOLOGY (BCIT)

BROADBAND AND DIGITAL EQUITY

The BDE team has been actively engaged in a variety of community outreach initiatives aimed at enhancing program development, fostering digital equity, and supporting key community events. One highlight is the planning of Digital Inclusion Week events. Upcoming highlights include:

- Digital Equity Forum (October 8): An event bringing together policymakers, community leaders, educators, and tech experts to discuss strategies for advancing digital equity.
- Digital Equity Public Meeting (October 9): A public feedback session designed to gather input from the broader community on digital equity needs and opportunities.
- Digital Equity Resource Fair (October 11): A community resource fair focused on providing tools and services to help individuals improve their digital literacy and access.

In addition to this community engagement work, BDE has connected 46 recreation centers and 5 senior centers to the City's free public wi-fi network—FreeBmoreWifi. Work is underway with the

Housing Authority of Baltimore City (HABC) and other partners to bring broadband connectivity to 8 public housing locations in the City.

HARDWARE REFRESH, CITIWATCH, AND HYBRID MEETING ROOM

BCIT has refreshed 256 PCs through August 2024 and has upgraded 12 meeting rooms with hybrid capabilities and expects that next group of rooms will be completed in September. The team is currently reviewing bids for a citywide personal computer hardware contract, targeting to make an award at the Board of Estimates in November.

BCIT has begun installation of the hardware needed to improve the CitiWatch camera infrastructure, and now 11 out of 45 cameras are supported by updated hardware.

TAX MODERNIZATION SOFTWARE

BCIT has obligated all \$4,000,000 of its allocation to procure a 3-year subscription for revX Revenue and Property Tax SaaS software from Revenue Solutions, Inc., which will replace existing property and other miscellaneous tax systems in Baltimore City. With the contract executed, this project will not have significant updates to provide on a monthly basis.

MAYOR'S OFFICE OF HOMELESS SERVICES (MOHS)

MOHS continues to advance its ARPA-funded initiatives. Fifty-one percent of MOHS's \$71.5 million in ARPA funds have been expended as of the end of August 2024.

- The Housing Accelerator Fund subgrant agreements for nine organizations have been approved by the Board of Estimates or they are in the last stages of submission for approval by the BOE.
- The Rapid Resolution and Shelter Diversion Fund program will conclude by October 1, 2024.
- The Rapid Rehousing program, funded through the Shelter Demobilization grant, will also conclude by October 1, 2024.

- Located at 3 Pratt Library branches, Housing Navigators continue to provide resources and connect residents to services.
- Through the Shelter Operations and Acquisition grant, MOHS is coordinating with DGS to complete renovations at the Weinberg Housing Resource Center, the City's largest emergency shelter. ARPA continues to fund leasing costs at a 150-room hotel dedicated to sheltering women experiencing homelessness.

MOHS has had significant advancements in implementing ARPA funded programs. The Rapid Rehousing and Flex Fund projects will be completed in October 2024. The RFP for the hotel conversion has received 5 potential developers and the review of the applications are in process.

MAYOR'S OFFICE OF NEIGHBORHOOD SAFETY AND ENGAGEMENT (MONSE)

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT & OPPORTUNITY (CE&O)

MONSE's Coordinated Neighborhood Stabilization Response (CNSR) team is actively collaborating with the Oliver Center following the Oliver mass shooting in mid-August. The partnership aims to assist returning citizens in finding employment and building pathways to stable reintegration. MONSE also organized a Back-to-School Praise Tunnel to welcome students back to school following the recent mass shooting, providing a space for healing, support, and community strength.

RE-ENTRY

The Re-Entry Council meeting was held on August 25th, where MONSE discussed ongoing initiatives and strategies for supporting returning citizens. The group worked on issues such as how to streamline the transportation process.

MONSE conducted a site visit and tour behind the walls of the Maryland Women Correctional Institute (MWCI) gaining valuable insights into the facility and its programs. This was a joint visit with the MONSE Intimate Partner Violence (IPV) Prevention Team.

GROUP VIOLENCE REDUCTION STRATEGY (GVRS)

MONSE hired a Community Partnership Manager and extended a final offer to our Service Partnership Manager positions. Additionally, Youth Advocate Programs (YAP) has recently hired and onboarded a new director to strengthen community efforts. The Service Partnership Manager meets with YAP every Tuesday to review case management and ensure effective support for individuals in the program.

COMMUNITY VIOLENCE INTERVENTION (CVI)

The Belvedere, Franklin Square, and Park Heights Safe Streets sites celebrated 365 days without a homicide in their respective catchment zones.

MAYOR'S OFFICE OF IMMIGRANT AFFAIRS (MIMA)

BALTIMORE NEW AMERICANS ACCESS COALITION (BNAAC)

BNAAC services at Esperanza Center and GR Welcome Center will be extended by 12 months. MIMA and Global Refuge will train continuing partners on BNAAC process updates and shifts in September, in preparation to lift the enrollment pause. The shifts include enrolling only families with US born children, additional documentation and database requirements and adjusting the timeline to provide financial assistance. MIMA and BCF are in the process of drafting amendments to CBO contracts for no-cost extensions. Global Refuge and MIMA completed monitoring activities in August, and shared feedback with CBOs who will provide responses to the feedback. MIMA continues to hold biweekly one-on-one calls with CBOs to closely monitor case closures and completion of database action steps. CBOs continue to connect open cases to public benefits and other community resources including assistance with Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) redetermination submissions and referrals to low-cost dental services and plans.

In the past month of August outreach tabling and resource sharing occurred at Block parties in Highlandtown and Frankford and back to school

events in the neighborhoods Brooklyn, Curtis Bay and Moravia Park. As well as the Mayor's back to school event where immigrant families were transported to the event. Interviews for the qualitative analysis also occurred at all 4 of the partner sites.

In the next month a targeted outreach approach will occur with partner Global Refuge. The project will focus on building referral pathways with French and African immigrants. This will include meetings with partners and trusted messengers in the community like IOSC and AFRI thrive. The next phase of the qualitative analysis will also occur, this is where interviews will be synthesized, and an initial report will be produced.

LANGUAGE ACCESS

By July 31, nearly half of language access liaisons had completed the language access training in Workday. MIMA will continue to monitor and track staff training in the coming months, with the help of DHR, and support agency liaisons. City agencies are required to include protocols for staff training on language access in their language access plans, for both existing staff and future hires.

In August, MIMA received interpretation equipment. The equipment will be used to facilitate interpretation in up to six different languages at a single event, or one language in up to six events happening simultaneously. MIMA has already developed a protocol for agencies to follow when they would like to request this equipment and has started to develop a user guide for Agency staff. MIMA expects to make the equipment available for City agencies to utilize at events, meetings and other functions to facilitate communication with limited English proficiency (LEP) residents by October 2024.

By late August, 4 of the 5 City agencies in Cohort 3 had submitted an early/first draft of their agency's language access plans. MIMA provided initial feedback on those draft plans, which included suggestions for further developing plans in certain areas (e.g. staff training, language access services). Each agency has the option to send a second draft for MIMA's feedback, which must be finalized by September 30.

Also in August, MIMA finalized a project with Wide Angle Youth Media to design "I Speak" posters

and wallet cards to help the public—especially LEP persons—understand their right to ask for and receive language assistance. MIMA plans to print the posters this Fall and will distribute the posters to City agencies for display in public spaces/office building and other locations where they encounter the public. MIMA will print out wallet cards and distribute the cards through community partners to inform LEP residents of their right to ask for assistance with City services in their language. MIMA also ordered copies of LanguageLine's Language ID cards, which can help City agency staff to identify the language of an LEP person they may encounter.

In August, MIMA also participated in several events in partnership with the Mayor's Office, including Rock the Block at Furley Elementary School, and in Highlandtown. MIMA participated in the Mayor's Back to School event and helped guide, support and register LEP families as they navigated the activities during the event, including picking up a free backpack for each student and accessing information and services provided by City and external vendors. MIMA also presented on its language access program and work to reduce barriers for LEP persons to City services and programs to an audience of Spanish-speaking/dominant families whose children are enrolled as students in Baltimore City Public Schools. Also, MIMA held a meeting of the Language Access Oversight Committee on Wednesday, August 28, providing updates on staff training, progress on language access plan development, and other tools and resources MIMA has developed to support City agencies.

In September, MIMA will present on its language access work with City agencies to the participants of MIMA's New American Leadership Institute. In October, MIMA will present on a panel to share more about its Language Access Program, and the city's language and advocacy strategies to an audience of library staff during a conference taking place at the Enoch Pratt Free Library.

DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT (DHCD)

IMPACT INVESTMENT AREAS

The pre-proposal conference for 1313 Druid Hill Avenue, which was stabilized using ARPA funds, will be held in September. Also, Rebuild Metro will begin work on 508 E Preston Street in Johnston Square. Acquisitions are continuing to move forward as the majority are with the Law Department for condemnation and several negotiated sales are being prepped for settlement.

PERMITTING SYSTEMS UPGRADES

The First Amendment to the Master Service Agreement is scheduled for the October 2nd BOE. The agency will be holding demonstrations for internal and external stakeholders as well as focus groups of the permitting system.

BALTIMORE SHINES

The Baltimore Shines project through the Civic Works Energy Program has serviced a total of 17 households with solar installations and has referred approximately 800 residents to other housing and utility bill resources.

WEALTH BUILDING

The Wealth Building project continues to assist residents in middle neighborhoods with critical repairs to homes. There are approximately 542 households on the application list with a projected 88 cases to be completed.

DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING (DOP)

MIDDLE NEIGHBORHOODS CDC

DOP has reported an increase in inquiries about accessing rehabilitation loans in the York Road neighborhoods due to an increase in Healthy Neighborhoods sponsored bulk mailers. The organization also sent mailers regarding the Govans Farmers Market which features fresh produce from local farmers and ARPA funded incentives for purchasing healthy food options.

FOOD INSECURITY

The Produce Rx program has reported patient successes and improvement in conditions because of diet and medication interventions. Patients have seen reductions in hypoglycemic events and improved kidney function.

The Online SNAP team is hosting its stakeholder network at Food PAC to acknowledge and celebrate their Resident Food Equity Advisor cohort. This cohort will be centered around resident feedback about the online SNAP initiative.

The Farmers Market Incentives program has ended their partnership with the Novo Dia Group who served as the e-Incentives technology platform and has signed a new contract with Healthy Together by Twenty Labs. The goal is to launch the new platform by the end of September. The platform and users will be able to process both Farmer's Market Incentives as well as Farmer's Market Nutrition Program Incentives.

CLEAN CORPS

In August, Clean Corps held a successful career fair in partnership with the Mayor's Office for Economic Development. The purpose of this event was to share resources to help Clean Corps workers become career ready. A total of 66 Clean Corps participants attended the event and several vendors offering behavioral health supports also attended. A total of 11 people signed up for these services, in addition, Maryland Volunteer Legal Services provided expungement services—with 34 people inquiring about this service and four applications completed the same day. From that session, MOED assisted five Clean Corps workers in completing applications for GED classes and GED examinations. As of the end of August, three out of five workers completed the exam and are awaiting the results.

Clean Corps secured two additional partnerships to support the expansion of regional cleaning teams: One with South Baltimore Gateway Partnership to stand up a new team in four South Baltimore neighborhoods and another with Healthy Neighborhoods Initiative along the Liberty Heights Corridor.

In August, Clean Corps partnered with Forest Park High School for their Summer Camp Career Day.

The focus of the event was neighborhood cleanliness with guest speakers from local landscaping companies as well as DPW sharing information with students about careers. The students identified locations around the school for cleaning and Clean Corps crews led them in the work. A total of 65 students participated and managed to remove approximately .22 tons of waste in under three hours. DOP will be hosting a similar event with Forest Park High School in November and are looking to partner with more schools in other areas.

DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES (DGS)

BALTIMORE POLICE DEPARTMENT (BPD) FLEET

DGS has received 93 of the 100 BPD Police Interceptor Utilities (PIUs) ordered using ARPA funds. The remaining 7 BPD PIUs are estimated to be delivered in October 2024. Of the vehicles received, 50 have been upfitted, and 38 are now in service.

DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS (DPW) LOAD PACKERS

DGS fleet has received all 20 ARPA-funded load packers. All 20 units have been upfitted, tagged, and labeled and are now in service.

HVAC IMPROVEMENTS AT CITY LIBRARIES

Design work is underway for the six library branches receiving HVAC repair and replacement. At this time, DGS expects that construction at the Brooklyn and Northwood libraries will be completed first. Construction for all six libraries is expected to conclude by October 2025.

CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS

Construction for the Northwest Community Action Center project is underway. DGS has placed signage at the Center informing building users and visitors about the ongoing roof and storefront replacement project. Work is expected to be completed in October 2024.

DGS is currently working to procure a City Hall Roof project contract.

Two interagency agreements were executed with DGS to carry out facility improvements at Baltimore City Fire Stations. These include roof replacements, bathroom renovations, and other facility upgrades. DGS has amended and procured all contracts to carry out these improvements. Construction is expected to start shortly for facility upgrades, and roof replacements are slated to be completed by December 2024.

DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS (DPW)

WASTE REMOVAL

DPW is utilizing ARPA funding to cover a contract for Spindler Refuse Service, Inc. to provide residential trash and recycling hauling for one year to help return to weekly recycling services. This contract will conclude in October 2024.

RECYCLING CREWS

All 30 ARPA-funded recycling crew positions (10 solid waste drivers and 20 solid waste workers) were hired in January 2024. These roles experience elevated turnover rates across the industry, a trend that similarly impacts DPW. As of August, one driver position and one solid waste worker position reopened, and DPW is working to fill these roles promptly.

CAPITAL AND OPERATING IMPROVEMENTS

DPW will utilize ARPA funds for capital improvements at Bowley's Lane and for operating improvements across the Department of Solid Waste. Operating improvements include purchasing new technology and equipment, including mini-load packers, tractors, and bobcats. DPW is currently working to amend existing contracts to include specific ARPA language. Capital improvement work will be anticipated to begin in the coming months. A portion of the vehicle purchases have already been ordered and spend down will occur as vehicles are delivered.

BALTIMORE CITY FIRE DEPARTMENT (BCFD)

BCFD is utilizing ARPA funding for the strategic acquisition of life-saving equipment. The equipment

includes self-contained breathing apparatuses, thermal imaging cameras, hose replacements, and rain hoods. The hose replacements are slated to be delivered in March 2025. The self-contained breathing apparatuses and thermal imaging cameras will be ordered in October 2024 and are expected to be delivered within six months. The contract for the rain hoods is tentatively scheduled for approval by the Board of Estimates in October.

BCFD is also partnering with DGS on facility updates to BCFD facilities.

DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (DOT)

BCDOT issued a Notice to Proceed for the ADA Ramp East Reconstruction contract on August 28, 2024 and issued another for the ADA Ramp West Reconstruction contract on September 9, 2024. Construction is progressing on the Citywide ADA Reconstruction contract, with 61 ramps completed to date.

The contract for the Sidewalk Repair project is targeted to be awarded in October 2024.

BALTIMORE CITY PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM (BCPSS)

The RFP for City Springs design services is in legal review and being prepared for posting. The Edmondson design services RFP draft is nearing completion and will be sent for legal review. For Northwestern High School, 45 classrooms have temporary A/C installed, with the full installation anticipated to be complete by April 2025. Permanent A/C installation is complete for the cafeteria and library.

Performance Measures and Metrics

Table 3 includes a select number of performance measures. Measures should not be viewed as underperforming since many programs or data collection are just beginning. The Recovery Office will continue to coordinate with sub-recipients on measure accuracy. Additional data on performance measures will be included in Council reports as programs are further implemented and data becomes available. POPULATION, LABOR & EMPLOYMENT GROWTH
