## Background

This memorandum accompanies the City of Baltimore Mayor's Office of Recovery Program's submission of its monthly report to the City Council on spending and performance related to American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding. Specifically, Council Bill 21-0121 § 49-2(B) prescribes the elements of legislatively required reporting, which stipulates that monthly reports should:

- 1) Provide data and metrics regarding how the funds have:
  - I. Increased the effectiveness of city government services;
  - II. Broadened the reach of city government services;
  - III. Made city government services more efficient;
  - IV. Made city government services more sustainable
  
- 2) Identify key performance indicators, benchmarks, and targets related to:
  - I. Equity, as defined in Article 1, § 39-1 of the Baltimore City Code;
  - II. Population Growth;
  - III. Labor and Employment;
  - IV. Economic Growth, especially the growth of minority and women-owned businesses; and,
  - V. Community Benefit

## Commitments and Expenditures

At the end of March 2023, the Mayor's Office of Recovery Programs has committed \$563.4 million in ARPA funds to City agencies, quasi-governmental organizations, and nonprofits to advance priority initiatives for the benefit of Baltimore City residents. Through March 2023, about \$90.1 million dollars has been spent on ARPA-funded projects (See Table 1), accounting for about 16% of the current commitments and 14% of the city's \$641M total ARPA allocation.

# Commitments

Table 1 lists ARPA commitments totaling \$563,333,095 with not in new commitments for the month. Expenditures total \$90,097,228 through March 2023.

## Recovery Office Accomplishments

The Mayor’s Office of Recovery Programs awarded ARPA funding to 45 nonprofit organizations. As of March 2023, a total of 42 nonprofits have received disbursements totaling \$12.8M. In March alone, the Recovery Office disbursed \$1.1M. Further, a total of 38 nonprofits have started expending funds—at a total of \$3.1M. See Table 1 for information on total disbursements to nonprofits. In addition, some highlights of select nonprofits’ activities in March are as follows:

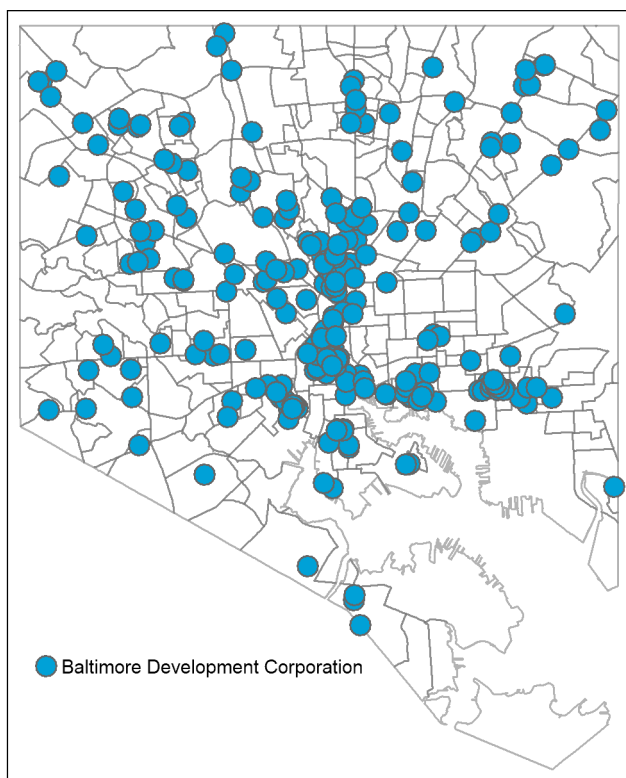
- The Pro Bono Resource Center provided 12 homeowners with foreclosure prevention legal counseling and helped prepare advanced planning documents for seven homeowners. Additionally, Pro Bono Resource Center held one tax sale prevention clinic and provided four tax sale consultations.
- Everyman Theatre hosted 3,305 audience members, served 178 students through educational programming, and sold 731 tickets using affordability options, such as Pay What You Choose, Half-Price Tickets, Student Discounts, or other discounts.
- No Boundaries Coalition Youth Organizers hosted a House Meeting (Youth Community Meeting) which was well attended by over 20 youth and community partners including Johns Hopkins School of Public Health and Youth As Resources.

# Subawardee Accomplishments

## *Economic Recovery Fund*

Eight hundred eighty-six (886) grants, totaling \$16,744,387, have been awarded from Economic Recovery Fund fiscal agents to beneficiaries, including nonprofits and small businesses (See Appendix for a complete list of organizations). Four out of five fiscal agents have completely disbursed grant funds. The remaining fiscal agent—Baltimore Development Corporation (BDC)—continues to disburse grants to its subrecipients. The map below indicates the location of all organizations funded by (BDC) through March 2023.

## *Baltimore Civic Fund (BCF) Economic Recovery Assistance*

BCF will be expending its final dollars for its \$8.3 million grant award by July 2023, when the cohort of participating nonprofits completes their technical assistance program. Following that, there will be no additional updates until BCF provides 6- and 12-month follow-ups on its Round 2 beneficiaries in the coming months.

## *Baltimore Development Corporation (BDC) Economic Recovery Assistance*

BDC has been updating its data reporting over the last quarter. BDC completed second payments to 20 business awardees from Round 1 a total of \$235,419, and paid 63 business awardees from Round 2 a total of \$530,826.50. BDC is continuing to prepare payments for Round 2 awardees. Additionally, BDC has partnered with Morgan State University (MSU) to conduct a program evaluation of the effectiveness of providing technical assistance to small business awardees. MSU



is evaluating Round 1 awardees this year and will evaluate Round 2 awardees pending available funding next year.

### *Visit Baltimore Economic Recovery Assistance*

Visit Baltimore has fully expended its award and will not have a new status update until the 12-month follow-up survey, which will be conducted in April 2023.

### *Family League Economic Recovery Assistance*

The Family League of Baltimore City has fully expended its \$2 million grant award and disbursed funds to 182 child daycare providers. Subsequently, FLBC has completed reporting on the performance of its beneficiaries.

### *CASH Campaign - Guaranteed Income Pilot*

March payments were successfully delivered to program participants. Since the onboarding process concluded, many participants have already improved their housing and working circumstances. One mother, for example, was working three part-time positions when the pilot began; however, she has now secured a full-time position in a field she would like to pursue.

While many participants rent apartments or live in multi-generational households, there were also participants who identified as unhoused when the program began. CASH Campaign has confirmed that those individuals have found secure housing or are beginning the process to secure housing.

CASH released a newsletter to everyone who signed up for the Guaranteed Income news action alerts, which has approximately 2,000 email addresses enrolled. This newsletter provides resources, important details, updates, and upcoming events; it also provides an opportunity for counseling services for community members seeking financial assistance. The newsletter is also used to share relevant opportunities, events, and resources to participants such as Money Power Day and the Mayor's Youth Summit.

On March 18, 2023, CASH hosted its 16th annual Money Power Day®, which is the region's largest free financial fitness fair. GI pilot participants were invited to attend and join activities designed to inspire and inform on how to boost their financial power. The goals of the event are to:

- Expose residents to, and provide residents with, quality financial services such as financial planning, housing counseling, and credit counseling; and financial education through a suite of informational workshops
- Increase awareness of financial issues and supportive services available to low-wealth workers in Baltimore
- Expand CASH's client base and outreach into Baltimore communities.

## City Agencies Accomplishments

### *Baltimore City Recreation and Parks (BCRP)*

In March, BCRP scheduled the start of athletic court resurfacing projects for a number of locations that occurred in April. BCRP is processing requisitions under its Cooperative Agreements for various playground projects.

Towanda and Coldstream pool projects are still in design and preparing to bid for construction. While the Gardenville and Curits Bay Rec Center projects are still in design, the Furley Recreation Center construction contract has been awarded. The Gwynn Falls Trail project is still in design and preparing to bid for construction.

Finally, BCRP held community meetings on April 10 and April 13 for the Greater Model Pool project and the Curtis Bay Recreation Center respectively.

### *Baltimore City Health Department (BCHD)*

The BCHD Vaccination team has selected a vendor through a Request For Applications (RFA) process to support BCHD's effort to increase access to COVID-19 vaccines, particularly in underserved communities, through direct service provision, training, care coordination, targeted outreach, and evaluation.

The Adult Guardianship team has hired all 5 case manager positions with the help of recruitment through Baltimore Corps.

Finally, the BCHD Communications team put out advancements: Stories placed for End of Public Health Emergency, Press Conference (End of Public Health Emergency), End of Public Health Emergency Memo/End of Public Health Emergency Video Developed. The Communications team also continued to develop its general COVID Communications Strategy.

### *Broadband and Digital Equity (BDE)*

The Digital Equity Fund Request for Applications (RFA) was released by the Baltimore Civic Fund in April 2023. The Digital Equity Fund is an initiative to support the creation of community-led digital inclusion plans and provide funding for communities to bring those plans to life. The Digital Equity Fund was allotted \$1 million in American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding for this grant cycle. Applications are open from April 10 to June 2, 2023.

In addition, for the Broadband and Digital Equity initiative overall, the stakeholder engagement process is ongoing. This group's assignment is to update the digital equity framework originally released in 2021. The group has completed the first draft for internal review. The final draft will be socialized to the relevant agencies for review.

## *Mayor's Office of Homeless Services (MOHS)*

The Housing Accelerator Fund application has been completed and the Inter-Agency Agreement between MORP and MOHS is in the draft review stage. The ARPA initiative has increased collaboration between DHCD and MOHS resulting in what will be improved outcomes for people experiencing homelessness. The HOME ARP application which serves as a critical component of the Housing Accelerator Fund Project was approved by HUD. The Training Institute which serves as a valuable resource for developers and landlords participating in the program is in the process of being launched.

Hiring is actively occurring for Housing Coordinators who will be tasked with MOHS program onboarding and implementation. The parameters for the Landlord Engagement Fund have been determined and the SOPs are in the process of being finalized.

Finally, MOHS continues to engage the community and all stakeholders through the Baltimore City Continuum of Care, the Leadership Committee, and the many workgroups and committees involved in the work of homelessness services.

## *Mayor's Office of Neighborhood Safety and Engagement (MONSE)*

**Group Violence Reduction Strategy (GVRS):** In March, MONSE successfully developed new program KPIs based on GVRS expansion into the Southwestern District, and also finalized contracts with community partners Youth Advocate Programs (YAP) and ROCA. In response to a recent mass shooting within the broader Upton neighborhood, a community resource fair was organized on Tuesday, April 4th.

**Community Engagement and Opportunity (CE&O):** In advance of the Returning Citizens Behind the Wall (RCBTW) program soft launch on April 10th, MONSE modified the existing MOU to designate the Department of Public Safety and Correction Services (DPSCS) as the fiduciary of the grant. Moving forward, DPSCS will handle payment and participant hours; MONSE will be tracking their progress through invoices and audits. Additionally, and in collaboration with the Mayor's Office of Employment Development (MOED) and DPSCS, MONSE is developing safe return plans that will help ensure participants have access to employment opportunities and resources upon release.

During the most recent reporting period, MONSE attended several community association meetings. Staff also attended a community association meeting in Frankford, where MONSE is currently developing a 45-day proactive community stabilization. This followed a walk-through of the impacted community with BPD.

In addition, MONSE coordinated a Women's re-entry focus group with PIVOT Baltimore on Wednesday, April 5. Other focus groups included a youth re-entry focus group at the Center for Urban Families on Thursday, April 6, and a LatinX focus group at the Mora Crossman Recreation Center on April 20th.

Following the creation of the Re-Entry Action Council (RAC, comprising a cross section of city agencies, members of the community with lived experience, and providers), MONSE hosted its first re-entry focus group. The RAC will serve as an advisory body to MONSE, and the team is currently reviewing prospective applicants to join the board. The initial focus group meeting concerned barriers to male-identifying returning citizens and their experiences throughout the re-entry process. The group discussed issues related to housing, employment, and the need for more seamless coordination of services. Understanding these challenges will ultimately inform the inaugural work of the RAC.

**Community Violence Interventions (CVI):** In March, there was a 0% change in homicides from this time last year in locations associated with Safe Streets. Shootings in these areas are also down

25% year-to-date. By next month, MONSE's goal will be to have CVI performance reporting from contracted partners.

**Intimate Partner Violence (IPV):** The volume of participants involved in the House of Ruth Gateway Project have increased, and the Victim Services team has seen positive reception from the court program. However, there is evidence to suggest that some judges are referring cases from outside Baltimore City to House of Ruth, reducing capacity and the share of referrals made to a local Community Based Organization (CBOs).

Turnaround, Inc., one of MONSE's CBO grantees, will be moving away from CVI and towards a more community focused abuse intervention program (AIP)-oriented training for youth. Previously, this work was designated to three high schools under the CVI umbrella, but an expansion is currently underway to increase the number of CBOs who can be aligned to the project.

**Grant Awards:** The following ARPA-funded grant awards were Approved by the BoE March 1st: • The Community Builders Inc. (Competitive ARPA Award) - \$25,000. • Holistic Life Foundation Inc. (Competitive ARPA Award) - \$50,000. • Fusion Partnership Inc./Ceasefire (Competitive ARPA Award) - \$75,000. • We Our Us (Competitive ARPA Award) - \$75,000. The following ARPA-funded grant awards were Approved March 15th: • Associated Catholic Charities Esperanza Center (Competitive ARPA Award) - \$25,000.

### *Mayor's Office of Employment Development (MOED)*

Seventeen Train Up Occupational Skills training providers continue to provide services, including 7 funded by City ARPA. All Support Services and Community Connectors contracts are also in place and services are in place. A total of 568 participants enrolled in Train Up Occupational Skills Training, of whom 193 are with City ARPA-funded programs. In total (including City and State ARPA-funded programs), 222 enrollees have obtained certifications, 289 have completed their training, and 121 have gained employment with an average hourly wage of \$18.47, well above the target of \$15.00. This count does not include an additional 24 jobs reported in early April. Many participants are still in training and the remaining completers are still in their job search phase.

A total of 217 unemployed/underemployed Baltimore City residents have received subsidized employment through Hire Up. Of these, 98 are funded by City ARPA. Including State-funded slots, 70 of those who remained in the program at least two weeks have transitioned to unsubsidized employment, 66 of whom reported an entry wage of \$15/hour or higher. MOED has developed partnerships with two additional worksites: Enoch Pratt Free Library and Hoodfellas. Worksites also include: the Baltimore City Department of Transportation, Department of Finance, Baltimore City Recreation and Parks Department, Department of Public Works, Parking Authority of Baltimore City, Downtown Partnership of Baltimore, the Mayor's Office of African American Male Engagement and MOED.

Hire Up and Train Up Project Managers continue to coordinate with two legal services providers, Maryland Legal Aid and Maryland Volunteer Lawyers Service as well as Associated Catholic Charities to provide behavioral health services. To date, at least 85 participants have taken advantage of free legal services (there has been a recent surge in legal services and that will be reflected in next month's report). 92 people have received group or individual behavioral health services. MOED is meeting regularly with Legal and Behavioral Health partners to identify and implement strategies to increase utilization of these services.

Through the Small Business Wage Subsidy, a total of 446 unemployed or underemployed residents have been hired at small, minority- or woman-owned businesses, and 446 subsidies have been paid to businesses thus far (paid upon 10 weeks of employment). Of these, 205 subsidies are supported by City ARPA. 96% of impacted business owners state they intend to hire their new staff permanently after 10 weeks and have reported retention of these employees at rates of 80%

and an average wage of \$20.61. According to the survey that was conducted for businesses that received the subsidy, the majority of benefiting businesses stated that they reinvested the subsidy to raise salaries and hire more people.

The YouthWorks 2023 portal closed April 7 for Baltimore City youth ages 14-21 to register and April 14 for worksites to register. During the registration period over 11,522 youth applied. The 5-week program will operate from July 10 to August 11. YouthWorks Academy began February 6 and provides job readiness and pre-employment opportunities to approximately 105 youth. Youth Advisory Council began March 13 and employs 10 youth as staff advising the Youthworks team.

### ***Mayor's Office of Performance and Innovation***

In the month of March, OPI completed working sessions with all 16 agencies and began to receive the first drafts of performance plans back from agencies. Working sessions consisted of hour-long walkthroughs of the template to build agency performance measures.

### ***Mayor's Office of Immigrant Affairs (MIMA)***

CBOs are steadily enrolling new clients. At the suggestion of CBOs and to meet client needs, the Baltimore New Americans Access Coalition (BNAAC) has changed the intake process to allow CBOs and clients to make use of available technology like WhatsApp, DocHub, and Zoom. On April 14<sup>th</sup>, MIMA held its first in-person, all-partners meeting at CASA.

During the reporting period, BNAAC members have presented to the MIMA Community Advisory Board, shared information at events including the Fallstaff resource fair and Pimlico Grow Center. MIMA is also collaborating with the MORP community engagement officer to create a multilingual insight video. In the upcoming weeks, MIMA will present to KIND- Kids In Need of Defense and the Latinos Providers Network, as well as attending community events like BenFest at Benjamin Franklin High school, Patterson High Cultural Festival, and Dia del Nino.

### ***Baltimore Digital Team - Digital Services***

The Digital Services team is now fully staffed. The team is working to identify and prioritize projects that would directly benefit City residents seeking services from the City. One of the team's first projects is a digital application and workflow for special events and block party permits. They are working on a soft launch of this application and engaging event organizers to better understand their needs and preferences.

### ***Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD)/Housing***

A presentation was made to City Council on the New Permit Reform/overhaul efforts. DHCD in collaboration with BCIT completed the vendor requirements audit and evaluation for the new software.

DHCD conducted a small group discussion with external stakeholders to discuss and gather information to better understand building and development permitting challenges in Baltimore City and recommendations for future improvement. Also, a customer service survey was sent to over 20,000 ePermits users. DHCD also met with the Baltimore Chapter of the Maryland Building Industry Association Representatives to gather input on ePermitting challenges. In the next 1-2 months, the plan is to finalize the vendor evaluation and procurement process for the new system.

DHCD has made significant progress in its Impact Investment Area Neighborhood Relief Fund with abstract title work and appraisals of vacant properties in the 7 selected impact areas.

## *Department of Planning (DOP)*

**Food Insecurity:** Two vendor contracts for the Online SNAP incentive program entitled B'more Fresh were approved by the BOE. The contracts with Safeway and Giant will provide online incentives for SNAP recipients. The third vendor contract for the program is in the legal review stage. DOP plans to add an additional two online retailers in the coming months.

The Subgrant agreement with Harbor Hospital, Inc. for the Prescription Rx program will be submitted for BOE approval. This project works to provide produce Rx meals for individuals screened for food insecurity by MedStar Hospital.

**Clean Corp:** The Clean Corp program now has three grantees who are working to help clean Baltimore. The grantees are Park Heights Renaissance who is cleaning Greenspring and Arlington neighborhoods, Civic Works which is cleaning Coldstream Homestead Montebello, Darley Park and Four by Four, and Lazarus Rite which is cleaning Druid Heights, Harlem Park, Upton, Sandtown-Winchester and Penn North. The Department of Planning as well as supporting agencies such as BCF, MORP and the Law Department also continue to respond to numerous inquiries and requests from one councilmember.

Privately owned lots that are in violation of Baltimore City Code and did not have previously opened citations were issued notices. Several lots were identified for compliance issues, however, those properties will be monitored closely moving into the warmer high grass months.

## *Department of General Services (DGS)*

**BPD Fleet:** DGS is currently awaiting the delivery of the BPD fleet hybrid vehicles in order to perform upfitting to BPD's specifications.

**HVAC Improvements at City Libraries:** Funding will be used by DGS to make capital improvements to HVAC systems at City libraries in order to meet the CDC recommended ventilation standards and address repair issues. Library locations will be selected based on various criteria including HVAC system physical conditions, equity considerations, number of users, and energy usage of existing equipment.

During March, DGS finalized the scope of work for the HVAC Repair in Pratt Library Facilities projects and developed a PowerPoint presentation to present to bidders at a pre-bid meeting.

In the next 1-2 months, DGS plans to hold site visits with potential vendors to review the HVAC conditions. From these visits, DGS should understand how the project will affect the various libraries in order to notify the public of the work and potential closures.

## **Performance Measures and Metrics**

As previously noted, many agencies are still fully designing and implementing programs; therefore, data are limited. A select number of performance measures are included in Table 3. Measures should not be viewed as underperforming since many programs or data collection are just beginning. The Recovery Office will continue to coordinate with subrecipients on measure accuracy. Additional data on performance measures will be included in Council reports as programs are further implemented, and data becomes available.

The Recovery Office anticipates including some targets and benchmarks for agency performance during the FY23 period of performance. As we continue to work coordinate with ARPA subrecipients on performance measures and goals, this report includes narrative information on agency accomplishments to date.

### *Population, Labor & Employment Growth*

Council legislation requires critical performance indicators, benchmarks, and targets related to population growth. No data source exists that would demonstrate population growth on a monthly basis. In addition, some ARPA funding may be used for programs and initiatives that could result in population growth. However, such instances would be anecdotal in nature and cannot be positively correlated to ARPA.

The Mayor’s Office of Recovery Programs continues to make significant progress in the awarding of ARPA funds, the monitoring of agency and organization’s progress, and in the accountability and transparency in the use of these funds.
