Background

This memorandum accompanies the City of Baltimore Mayor's Office of Recovery Program's submission of its monthly report to the City Council on spending and performance related to American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding. Specifically, Council Bill 21-0121 § 49-2(B) prescribes the elements of legislatively required reporting, which stipulates that monthly reports should:

- 1) Provide data and metrics regarding how the funds have:
 - I. Increased the effectiveness of city government services;
 - II. Broadened the reach of city government services;
 - III. Made city government services more efficient;
 - IV. Made city government services more sustainable
- 2) Identify key performance indicators, benchmarks, and targets related to:
 - I. Equity, as defined in Article 1, § 39-1 of the Baltimore City Code;
 - II. Population Growth;
 - III. Labor and Employment;
 - IV. Economic Growth, especially the growth of minority and women-owned businesses; and,
 - V. Community Benefit

Commitments and Expenditures

At the end of November, the Mayor's Office of Recovery Programs has committed \$641.1 million in ARPA funds to City agencies, quasi-governmental organizations, and nonprofits to advance priority initiatives for the benefit of Baltimore City residents. Through November 2023, about \$153.4 million dollars has been spent on ARPA-funded projects (See Table 1), accounting for about 24% of the current commitments and of the city's \$641M total ARPA allocation.

Commitments

Table 1 lists ARPA commitments totaling \$641,170,126, the full Baltimore City ARPA allocation. Expenditures total \$154,712,702 through November 2023.

Recovery Office Accomplishments

The Mayor's Office of Recovery Programs directly awarded ARPA funding to 45 nonprofit organizations. As of November 2023, all 45 nonprofits have received disbursements totaling \$19.6 million. See Table 1 for information on total disbursements to nonprofits. In addition, some highlights of select nonprofit activities in November are as follows:

• On November 11, Pennsylvania Avenue Black Arts and Entertaiment District hosted a Solidarity Social - Artivism event, raising awareness about food justice in the Black Arts

District and surrounding communities. On November 18 and 19, the organization held a Black Artist Fair at Baltimore City Community College and at the Black Mall.

• On November 15, ReBUILD Metro hosted a public event with the community to celebrate the launch of construction of the Johnston Square Teacher Housing project, as well as to celebrate the completion of four housing rehabilitation projects on the 400 block of East Biddle Street. ReBUILD Metro has made significant progress on the stabilization construction at 430-438 East Biddle Street, the first five units in the Teacher Housing Project. Work completed to date includes interior demolition, basements, flooring, and framing.

In addition, the Recovery Office continues to provide technical assistance to all funded city agencies, quasi government agencies and nonprofits as well as coordinating with centralized functions such as legal, procurement and finance to facilitate timely disbursements and expenditures.

Subawardee Accomplishments

Economic Recovery Fund

There have been 1,055 grants awarded, totaling \$18,955,751, from Economic Recovery Fund fiscal agents to beneficiaries, including nonprofits and small businesses (See Appendix for a complete list of organizations). Four out of five fiscal agents have completely disbursed grant funds. The fifth fiscal agent—Baltimore Development Corporation (BDC)—continues to disburse grants to its subrecipients. The map below indicates the location of all organizations funded by BDC through November 2023. A map including the locations of other Economic Recovery Fund recipients can be found on the Recovery Office dashboard.




Figure 1: Organizations Funded by Baltimore Development Corporation

Baltimore Development Corporation (BDC) Economic Recovery Assistance

BDC processed a limited number of first and second checks – totaling 41 checks (8 first checks and 33 second checks). BDC continues to coordinate with businesses in Round 2 to gather and authenticate the necessary documentation to issue a first check. BDC is also coordinating with businesses on eligible uses of grant funding, as some businesses' needs have changed since submitting their application for funding.

City Agencies Accomplishments

Baltimore City Recreation and Parks (BCRP)

Shipley Hill and Radecke Park Playground Improvements were completed on time and on budget. The projects were complete replacements of the playground equipment and safety surfacing.

The initial informal bid for the Gwynns Falls Trail project that was to be advertised by the Bureau of Procurement was delayed because complications around the language in the solicitation. The Towanda and Coldstream pool project bid packets are under review by the Law Department and are targeted to be posted in the Fall/Winter 2023. The Gardenville Recreation Center solicitation was finalized last month and will be ready for bidding in December. The South Baltimore Recreation Center finalized schematic design and is progressing through design development.

Baltimore City Health Department (BCHD)

After much coordination with the Bureau of Procurement, the BCHD Testing team received its emergency procurement of at-home test kits and is actively working to deliver the kits to its partners, including food pantry and Pratt Libraries. With this shipment, BCHD has a sufficient supply of test kits through March 2024. About 22,500 at-home test kits were distributed at events and to partners.

The contact tracing staff are working with the Aging Division to increase vaccination at assisted living facilities and nursing homes to mitigate and prevent outbreaks in these facilities. Vaccination clinics are being planned for early January 2024.

BCHD held 44 community mobile clinics last month with 1,132 patients vaccinated. In addition, 62 homebound patients were also vaccinated. BCHD also has 18 scheduled community mobile clinics for the month of December.

The BCHD VALUE Communities team held 278 outreach events with an aggregate 24,981 people in attendance.

Baltimore City Information & Technology (BCIT)

Broadband and Digital Equity (BDE)

Public Wi-Fi

The BDE team has received 25 percent of the Wi-Fi equipment necessary for this project, including wireless access points, antennas, mounting kits, computer devices and accessories. ready to be deployed. Two BCRP recreation centers will have indoor and outdoor public Wi-Fi enabled by the end of December 2024.

Public Housing

In partnership with Housing Authority of Baltimore City (HABC), BDE has started construction for the Westport Homes, deploying fiber optic cable and establishing the other physical infrastructure necessary to extend the City's broadband network to public housing residents.

Digital Literacy and Community Engagement

Bmore Connected, the Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP) enrollment campaign, is in progress in collaboration with more than 20 stakeholder organizations. Since the launch of Bmore Connected, Baltimore has seen a 20% increase in ACP enrollment. BDE has purchased radio spots, MTA ads and billboards to advance this campaign through early 2024.

After being awarded 50,000 Chromebooks from the Office of Statewide Broadband, BDE partnered with Enoch Pratt Free Library to distribute these devices to income-eligible households across the City. Devices are currently being distributed at five Pratt locations, with expansions planned for early 2024.

In addition to these initiatives, BDE partnered with several community-based organizations to help them deliver resources to communities that have historically been left out of digital progress. One example is St. Lukes United Methodist Church in Sandtown-Winchester. A volunteer worked with a nearby senior center to coordinate a lunch-and-learn with older adults. During the event, the older adults provided insights on their technological struggles and their ideas to remediate or eliminate many barriers. BDE was able to provide direct instruction on tier 1 concerns (e.g., navigating cell phone apps and helpful websites). Approximately 50 older adults participated in the event.

Events like this follow the Mayor's guidance to set a hyper-local focus and provide support to community organizations, including faith-based institutions, as they take greater ownership in addressing barriers. This event serves as a template for greater community engagement. By investing in capacity at the community level, BDE can build more sustainable models with a more active and informed digital ecosystem.

Finally, BDE submitted formal comments, in partnership with Baltimore Digital Equity Coalition, to the Office of Statewide Broadband on the Maryland Digital Equity Plan. Comments were collected through multiple community and practitioner meetings in November, including two in-person feedback sessions at Pleasant View Gardens and City of Refuge – Baltimore.

BCIT - Hardware Refresh, CitiWatch, Hybrid Meeting Rooms

In December, BCIT and the Recovery Office finalized the Interagency Agreement that encompasses an \$8 million allocation to refresh 1,300 PCs across several City agencies, upgrade 20-25 meeting rooms with hybrid meeting capabilities, replace 185 CitiWatch cameras and refresh and replace the components of the infrastructure that support the CitiWatch system, replace switches, hubs, and access points (APs) which support the City's network infrastructure, and lastly, upgrade the existing Archibus software which will enable users to reserve the new hybrid meeting rooms.

In November, BCIT successfully hired a project manager to oversee the hybrid meeting room project, and fully encumbered the FY2024 allocation for CitiWatch hardware. BCIT also coordinated with the Law Department to finalize solicitations for PC Refresh solicitations.

Mayor's Office of Homeless Services (MOHS)

The Landlord Incentive and Flex Fund Programs launched. The ARPA Shelter Demobilization/Rapid Rehousing contracts were extended until March 31, 2024. The Notice Of Funding Availability (NOFA) for the Housing Accelerator Fund has resulted in 40+ applications currently in the initial review process. The 2nd NOFA for the Permanent Supportive Housing Training Institute and early Pre-Development funding for 6 new developer teams will be released by February and the Institute will be completed in July 2024. Finally, the Leadership Committee on Housing and Homelessness will restart in February 2024.

Mayor's Office of Neighborhood Safety and Engagement (MONSE)

Group Violence Reduction Strategy (GVRS)

To ensure consistent and comprehensive data collection, MONSE is finalizing a new template in Apricot for YAP participants. This will improve the agency's ability to monitor individual progress, receipt of services, and programmatic gains or concerns. The GVRS expansion to the Central District is slated to occur at the beginning of January, now that BPD has confirmed that it will provide the requisite staff by the end of December. Additionally, MONSE and MOED continue to coordinate towards finalizing a Memorandum of Understanding for the GVRS Transitional Employment program.

On December 20th, MONSE will co-facilitate a training for YAP personnel with David Muhammad, Executive Director of the National Institute for Criminal Justice Reform, around life coaching, best practices for continued engagement, relationship building, and effective data collection.

Community Engagement & Outreach (CE&O)

MONSE will incorporate trauma-informed care into each CNSR deployment, ensuring that victims have reliable access to these critical supports during periods of crisis and confusion. As previously indicated, MONSE also recently initiated a soft reset of the Neighborhood Policing Plan (NPP) to help solidify improved processes and stakeholder attendance. Notes from each meeting are now recorded by representatives from the University of Baltimore and sent to MONSE for review/redistribution. NPP sessions will also provide a space for stakeholders to review open/pending/closed service requests from the community. Trends gathered from this data, be it recurring localities or severity of issue(s), will be used to inform the itinerary of future NPP meetings. With this process, MONSE and its NPP partners have streamlined the meeting agenda to be more organized, tailored, and efficient than ever before.

Lastly, the MONSE data team recently developed a new 311 service request dashboard that will allow colleagues to track and update open service requests in real time. The proposed dashboard will be presented to colleagues at the University of Baltimore and Baltimore Police Department's in December, after which the agency will determine when and how best to incorporate this tool in future NPP meetings.

MONSE will conclude several CNSR deployments throughout the month of December. Both the proactive in Edmonson, as well as the stabilization on Hillen road, will be concluded over the coming days. The latter, a response to the mass shooting at Morgan State University, will

conclude once the agency receives commitments from Councilwoman Ramos and neighborhood association leader regarding post-stabilization efforts in community.

In addition, the Peace Mobile is scheduled for the following events:

- Edmondson Village When: December 5th at 2pm; Who: MONSE, MOED, BCRP, ROCA, WE ARE US, J.D. Merrill (representing the Mayor's Office); What: resource and community fair, concluding a proactive CNSR
- Baltimore Ravens home game When: December 10th; Who: Brooklyn Homes residents; What: Mayor Scott invited 20 individuals from the Brooklyn Homes community to attend the Ravens game against the Los Angeles Rams. MONSE will provide transportation via a chartered bus.
- Brooklyn Homes When: December 20th at 6pm; Who: Brooklyn Homes residents; What: A Christmas celebration event and resource fair, concluding the extended CNSR at Brooklyn Homes.
- City of Refuge (Brooklyn) When: December 12th at 6.30pm; Who: Brooklyn residents and the general public; What: Human-trafficking awareness and resource training.

Coordinated Neighborhood Stabilization Response (CNSR)

The extended stabilization in Brooklyn Homes will conclude at the end of 2023, marking the agency's longest and most significant CNSR to date. This CNSR also marks the first occasion in which MONSE maintained a regular presence throughout the post-stabilization period, providing invaluable insights into the agency's current process. Lessons collected from this CNSR will inform future deployments and best practices to ensure comprehensive data collection, sustained outreach, and long-term sustainability.

Community Violence Intervention (CVI)

MONSE recently met with partners at BPD, LifeBridge Health, and Catholic Charities to discuss the current hiring process for Safe Streets staff. As previously reported, hiring for gualified personnel has been a persistent challenge. These setbacks are due in part to technological limitations of screening software that lacks the capability of scanning for open cases, or whether an individual may be a person of interest and/or witness to a crime. These details are critical to the overall vetting process and have made it difficult for MONSE to determine if an individual should advance. Accordingly, MONSE also convened a meeting with the Deputy Mayor of Public Safety to determine a viable workaround that ensures a more complete criminal background check can be made available despite those technological challenges. Among other key takeaways, partners also determined that BPD should be represented on all interview panels moving forward. MONSE and its partner agencies are hopeful that these adjustments will expedite the hiring process for gualified candidates. The revised timetable for vetting applicants is now 3 weeks (in total, MONSE anticipates a 4-to-6-week selection process for all new applicants). This represents a vast improvement in overall efficiency and a win for interagency cooperation; one that will have lasting implications for both Safe Streets personnel and their surrounding neighborhoods. Specific attention will be given to hiring at Belair-Edison, and MONSE is working with local leaders, CBOs, and neighborhood associations to identify possible candidates. Safe Streets staffing data is now being included in Police Stat.

To help local communities stay connected this holiday season, Safe Streets is organizing special events and giveaways across all sites – including a combined thanksgiving turkey giveaway and coat drive in November.

Other events include: - Franklin Square hosted movie night on November 28th - Sandtown-Winchester organized a Thanksgiving Day dinner for neighborhood residents - Center for Hope facilitated additional turkey giveaways across their six sites - Penn-North hosted a glove and scarf giveaway on December 5th - Brooklyn Safe Streets staff will organize a community event to coincide with CNSR closeout.

Sites will continue to help organize and facilitate community programming through the end of the year, including winter giveaways (i.e. coats, gloves, hats), toy drives, and holiday food drives.

Mayor's Office of Immigrant Affairs (MIMA)

Baltimore New Americans Access Coalition (BNAAC)

Last month, LIRS Technical Assistance (TA) continued to onboard new benefit navigators and provided BNAAC Introductory training, Intake Training and 2 public benefit overview trainings to new hires. In addition, LIRS TA coordinate trainings in partnership with New American Careers, a new start up employment firm that aims to connect work authorized clients to employment opportunities in the area, MD Humanities to spotlight MD Humanities programming that BNAAC clients can participate in, and Esperanza Center's Victims of Crime case management program to which BNAAC clients may be referred for additional services if eligible. Esperanza Center reported participating at a community outreach event promoting BNAAC at John Rurah Elementary School in 21224, CASA participated in the Health and Wellness fair with MIMA in Brooklyn in November, and while LIRS WC did not report participation in community events, they report having an outreach plan in place and having increased interest in the BNAAC program through word of mouth. SECDC reported that they attended the Immigrant Resource Fair in October. To date, BNAAC Benefit Navigators have assisted clients to submit 997 applications for public benefits, with the highest rates of success being reported for Energy Assistance programs.

In the past month BNAAC held presentations for the Baltimore Medical Systems, the Medstar community health workers, and Afghan refugees. BNAAC also had an information table at the transformation center health fair, 4 library coat giveaways, the Barangay Baltimore Coat giveaway, the Curtis Bay Health Fair, and Maree Ferring Healthy Moms Event. In the next month BNAAC will also have a weekly information table at City of Refuge in South Baltimore, present at the Judy Center collaborative meeting, and plan events with a community stakeholder in Morell Park.

Language Access

Last month, MIMA was able to train all CAP Center staff on language access and the use of Language Line interpreters. Additionally, MIMA made progress on contracts with Wide Angle Youth Media and Xcelerate Media to develop outreach materials for LEP community members and an e-Learning training module on Language Access that will be available in Workday. MIMA also met with ECB, 311 Call Center, OECR, and the Law Department, which are all agencies that have been or will be involved in language access implementation. Additionally, MIMA met with the CAO to discuss the creation of a language access directive that will require City agencies' compliance with language access guidelines. This will provide the foundation for MIMA to begin working with agencies in Cohort 3 to implement language access, which is central to the ARPA Language Access Project. MIMA held its quarterly Language Access Oversight Committee. Committee members provided feedback on the proposed language access training content. MIMA also provided updates on work that was done to address issues that had been raised by committee members regarding access to City services for LEP residents.

Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD)

DHCD – Impact Investment Areas

DHCD has submitted eleven ARPA acquisitions for processing. DHCD will continue to submit acquisitions for approval as negotiation options are signed and condemnation is required. Properties are continuing to be identified for stabilization and HCD anticipates having a vetted list in Q1 of FY24.

DHCD- Permitting System Upgrades

The ProjectDox SAAS migration upgrade is projected to be on the late December BOE agenda. The project implementation of the permitting system upgrade project is advancing on schedule.

DHCD - Uplands

The public infrastructure phase of the Uplands Phase 2 redevelopment is on track and sitting currently at 82% completed. Uplands Rental 2A (78 Units) is at 30% while the Uplands Rental 2B (72 Units) is at 45% completion.

Department of Planning (DOP)

Food Insecurity

Online SNAP has seen an increase in incentive redemption for the online SNAP incentive program. As a result of Amazon who joined in August, October recorded the highest number of incentives redeemed to date. Additionally, the food insecurity team is making progress regarding communications and marketing to promote B'more Fresh more widely. As an example, the team hosted their first Resident Food Equity Advisor meeting in November, and participants of the cohort will serve as online SNAP advisors. DOP also received approval from the USDA Food and Nutrition Service to cover delivery costs and are working with the retailers to add delivery as an option for shoppers. In addition, the first Resident Food Equity Advisor Meeting took place with SNAP participants living in HABC public housing sites.

Produce Box Program

The team has visited 27 out of 32 distribution sites—with 5 remaining visits to occur. The goal is to complete visits by the end of calendar year 2024. The site visits continue to provide valuable insights and feedback from produce box partners.

Clean Corps

The Clean Corps team will begin a pilot project in collaboration with DPW in December. The project features three neighborhoods (Penn North, Coldstream Homestead and Montebello and Sandtown-Winchester) receiving up to twelve DPW forwarded work orders for Type I and Type II complaints including dumping, trash, and high grass and weeds. The expectation is that Clean Corps crews can service the complaints within an hour without the need for special tools and equipment. The crews will then forward before and after photos to DPW for processing.

Department of General Services (DGS)

Baltimore Police Department (BPD) Fleet

DGS has received 52 of the BPD Police Interceptor Utilities ordered using ARPA funds. The remaining 48 BPD Police Interceptor Utilities (PIUs) are estimated to be delivered in mid-2024. Upfitting has begun for the 52 vehicles received to-date.

Department of Public Works (DPW) Load Packers

The first two (2) ARPA-funded load packers are expected to be delivered by December 31, 2023. DPW is on track to receive three (3) additional load packers by January 31, 2024. The remaining load packers should be delivered by mid-2024.

HVAC Improvements at City Libraries

The finalized scope of work and locations for all Library HVAC repairs has been determined. DGS is in the final stages of the bid process and plans to award the contract in January.

Capital Improvements

The design and engineer's cost estimate for the City Hall roof is 100% complete. DGS has finalized the bid-ready specifications and submitted the bid-ready package to Contract Administration to start the procurement process.

The Northwest Community Action Center project is in the advertisement phase.

Department of Public Works (DPW)

Waste Removal

DPW will utilize \$3,285,000 in ARPA funding to cover a contract for Spindler Refuse Service, Inc. to provide residential trash and recycling hauling for one year in order to help return to weekly recycling services. The contract will end October 31, 2024.

Performance Measures and Metrics

A select number of performance measures are included in Table 3. Measures should not be viewed as underperforming since many programs or data collection are just beginning. The Recovery Office will continue to coordinate with subrecipients on measure accuracy. Additional data on performance measures will be included in Council reports as programs are further implemented, and data becomes available. Other performance measures can be found on the dashboard.
