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## Background

This memorandum accompanies the City of Baltimore Mayor's Office of Recovery Program's submission of its annual report to the City Council on spending and performance related to American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding. Specifically, Council Bill 21-0121 § 49-2(D) prescribes the elements of legislatively required reporting, which stipulates that annual reports include:

- I. An Assessment of Disbursement and Management of Funds;
- II. Disaggregated Data of Disbursement Recipients;
- III. Inequities Addressed by Funds;
- IV. Recommended Steps to Address and Resolve Identified Inequities; and,
- V. Updates Regarding Community Engagement

## Commitments and Expenditures

At the end of May, the Mayor's Office of Recovery Programs has committed \$641.1 million in ARPA funds to City agencies, quasi-governmental organizations, and nonprofits to advance priority initiatives for the benefit of Baltimore City residents. Through May 2024, about \$267.9 million dollars has been spent on ARPA-funded projects (See Table 1), accounting for about 42% of the current commitments and of the city's \$641M total ARPA allocation.

## Commitments

Table 1 lists ARPA commitments totaling \$641,170,126, and expenditures total \$267,902,927 through May 2024.

Notes: Commitment and expenditure data are through May 2024. Pending projects denotes financial commitments for projects that do not yet have a finalized budget. Contingency denotes funds set aside for unanticipated project costs. Revisions to commitment levels are generally reflected post-BOE approval or budget revisions. Changes to account numbers, accruals, delayed data entry, or other accounting related transactions impact the accuracy of spending data month-to-month. Accordingly, some expenditure data may change as accounting adjustments are made.

## Recovery Office Accomplishments

The Mayor's Office of Recovery Programs directly awarded ARPA funding to 45 nonprofit organizations. As of May 2024, all 45 nonprofits have received disbursements totaling \$28.7 million. See Table 1 for total disbursements. In addition, some highlights of select nonprofit activities in May are as follows:

- American Communities Trust signed its pre-construction agreement with the General Contractor. The General Contractor has started communications with all subcontractors to start construction.
- Downtown Partnership of Baltimore (DPOB) held a ribbon cutting for BOOST Harborplace on May 29th. All BOOST Harborplace awardees will be open and operational by early summer. DPOB will be promoting these businesses over the summer months on its social media platforms.
- Urban Strategies Inc. (USI) kicked off their summer programming. USI partnered with Art with a Heart, an agency that has a footprint within Perkins Somerset Oldtown (PSO) and has



worked to create a series of afterschool and out of school programming for children that span a year. Expanding this programming to children in case management ensures that USI can support families in getting their children into positive out of school time programming at no cost.

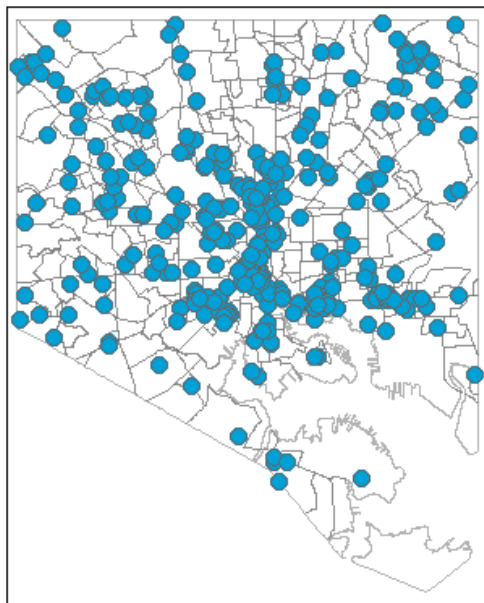
In addition, the Recovery Office continues to provide technical assistance to all funded city agencies, quasi government agencies and nonprofits as well as coordinating with centralized functions such as legal, procurement and finance to facilitate timely disbursements and expenditures.

## Subawardee Accomplishments

### *Economic Recovery Fund*

There have been 1,068 grants awarded, totaling \$20,078,696, from Economic Recovery Fund fiscal agents to beneficiaries, including nonprofits and small businesses (See Appendix for a complete list of organizations). Four out of five fiscal agents have completely disbursed grant funds. The fifth fiscal agent—Baltimore Development Corporation (BDC)—continues to disburse grants to its subrecipients. The map below indicates the location of all organizations funded by BDC through May 2024. ### *Baltimore Development Corporation (BDC) Economic Recovery Assistance*

BDC processed a limited number of second round checks – totaling 27 checks (2 second checks to Round 1 awardees, 1 first check to a second-round awardee, and 24 second checks to Round 2 awardees). BDC continues to coordinate with businesses in Round 2 to gather and authenticate the necessary documentation to issue checks. BDC is also coordinating with businesses on eligible

uses of grant funding, as some businesses' needs have changed since submitting their application for funding. BDC is also in the process of coordinating with the Recovery Office to review expenditures, budgets, and performance of the Technical Assistance (TA) partners in the BASE Network.

## City Agency Accomplishments

### *Baltimore City Recreation and Parks (BCRP)*

The contract for the Towanda and Coldstream Pool reconstruction projects were awarded in April 2024, BCRP expects work to begin in late June/early July. The Greater Model Pool project is scheduled to reach the Notice of Letting Stage in June and will be bid in early July 2024.

Two playgrounds were completed in May: Luzerne and Biddle, and Elmley. Patterson Park – Linwood Avenue and Bonview playgrounds will be complete in June/early July.

The Gwynns Falls Trail wayfinding signage project has been tentatively awarded, and the award is still under review by the Mayor's Office of Small and Minority Business Advocacy before the award can be finalized.

The two remaining Athletic Court resurfacing projects, Evesham and Briscoe Park, have not yet started, but are still on-track to be completed this year.

The South Baltimore Recreation Center project bid target date was pushed to July 2024. The Gardenview Recreation Center project has not yet started since the April 15<sup>th</sup> groundbreaking event, pending a permit, however the contractor is on-site preparing to begin work.

### *Baltimore City Health Department (BCHD)*

#### **Vulnerable Communities/Adult Guardianship**

The final two case manager positions have been filled, and a candidate for the Social Worker position is in the pre-hiring phase. BCHD has also hired an Administrative Assistant.

#### **Food Insecurity**

Highlights of this project are as follows:

- **Meals and Food Boxes:** With continued high levels of participation in this program, food insecurity persists as an issue among older adults. The program experienced the largest participation in home delivered meals this past month, exceeding 1,100 participants.
- **City of Refuge:** As described in last month's report, Comiendo Juntos (Eating Together) continues to have steady participation, and BCHD plans to build the capacity of the program from bi-monthly to a weekly service.
- **SNAP outreach:** BCHD's Baltimore Corps Fellows continue to work closely with Maryland Food Bank and Department of Planning to provide SNAP outreach and assistance. The Fellows attend senior centers with Maryland Food Bank to help center members apply for SNAP and provide any clarity around their SNAP benefits. A recent listening session with

older adults showed that while some older adults find the process challenging, others see that being on SNAP also qualifies them for additional programs and resources.

### **Vaccination**

BCHD has continued to provide community-based vaccine clinics throughout Baltimore City. The focus during the spring and summer months is protecting older adults who continue to be the most vulnerable to severe disease and death from COVID-19. To reach this population, the vaccination team has hosted clinics in senior apartments, nursing homes, assisted living facilities, and Baltimore City senior centers. BCHD's Homebound vaccination program continues, providing home visits for City residents in need of COVID and/or flu vaccination.

From May 2 until June 12, 2024, the Vaccine Acceptance and Access Lives in Unity, Education and Engagement (VALUE) Communities (VC) team has organized and led 38 engagement events in senior residences, community centers, churches, schools, universities, markets, and recreational centers. The nature of such events is to provide education on COVID-19 vaccination and testing, listen to Baltimore City residents' social and medical needs and provide a variety of resources that link clients to services. The types of these outreach events are health and resource fairs, food and diaper distribution, tabling, planning meetings and school meetings. For the remaining of June, the VC team has planned 14 more similar engagement events.

### **Communications**

BCHD's spring COVID vaccination ad campaign aired on TV, radio, and social media - encouraging older adults to stay up to date on the current COVID vaccine. To date, the social media ads have been displayed 1.6 million times. Billboards were also posted in 10 high-traffic areas around the City.

## ***Baltimore City Information & Technology (BCIT)***

### **Hardware Refresh, CitiWwatch, and Hybrid Meeting Rooms**

BCIT has met the target of replacing 185 Citiwatch cameras and for configuring 10 City conference rooms into hybrid meeting rooms. BCIT procured the hardware for switch refresh and is currently updating the schedule to deploy. BCIT partially received equipment for updating CitiWatch infrastructure for Southwest region.

### **Broadband and Digital Equity (BDE)**

#### *Community Engagement*

- **Chromebooks distribution:** Through this program, 27,340 Chromebooks have been distributed. The distribution partners including Thread, Maryland Family Network, HABC, Enterprise Community Development, Project Waves, and others have played a vital role in distribution efforts.
- **Employee Digital Skills:** With the focus around digital skills training, the program has a total attendance of 173 employees. In partnership with Department of Human Resources, BCIT-BDE has provided agency-specific training to Department Public Works, Baltimore City Recreation Parks, and Department of General Services.
- **Community Meeting Example:** In collaboration with the Midtown-Edmondson community association, BCIT-BDE conducted a public meeting to discuss the Midtown-Edmondson Master Plan. The BDE team provided detailed information on current developments and

solicited input from community members. A total of 20-25 participants attended this meeting.

- **Rural-Urban Digital Coalition Meeting:** The BDE team hosted a meeting for the Rural-Urban Digital Coalition, bringing together local and statewide representatives. The focus was on planning and obtaining feedback for the coalition's efforts to serve as a coordinating body for policy, funding, resources, and information dissemination across Maryland. A total of 9 participants attended this meeting.
- **Next Century Cities Conference:** BDE participated in the Next Century Cities 2024 [Bipartisan Tech Conference](#) on April 17th, 2024. BDE's Deputy Director was a keynote panelist.

### ***Mayor's Office of Homeless Services (MOHS)***

MOHS has had significant advancement in implementing ARPA funded programs. Two examples are: the Supportive Housing Institute, where teams are now applying for funds through the 2nd Notice of Funding Availability, and the Flex Fund which provided over \$174k in May to aid households in need and at risk of homelessness.

MOHS has created an annual report and publishes a monthly newsletter that highlight ARPA initiatives and provides current updates and information. Through the work with landlords, there is a monthly outreach to Providers, and MOHS is working in collaboration with United Way and the Housing Navigators across Baltimore City to ensure that Flex Funds are being used to reduce evictions and rapidly resolve homelessness.

### ***Mayor's Office of Neighborhood Safety and Engagement (MONSE)***

#### **Victim Services**

MONSE continues to improve coordination and communication among its victim services grantees, enhancing victim services' ability to address individual needs and provide more timely relocation services to individuals who may be currently housed in temporary accommodations and/or living in shelters.

MONSE is working with Turnaround, Inc. and House of Ruth on additional means that can be offered to help impacted individuals fully transition to safe, affordable housing. Moving individuals out of the shelter system and into permanent housing provides safe shelter for additional victims as they begin their own process of relocation. Research into potential funding and/or supports are currently underway.

The following events were scheduled to benefit victims and their families:

- The Mayor's Office of Immigration Affairs (MIMA), City of Refuge, and Casa hosted a Latinx resource fair in the Brooklyn community. Over 300 individuals were served. Additional resources were made available through the Guatemalan Embassy, ROAR, MOED, MOCFS, and the Mayor's Office of Constituent Services.
- Let's Thrive and Moms Demand Action hosted a special event in honor of Gun Violence Awareness Day. Both organizations helped facilitate healing gardens throughout the city.

while providing additional resources and a safe space for community to convene, share their experiences, and celebrate life.

### **Community Safety and Response**

MONSE recently supported a target enforcement action on North Avenue as part of its Neighborhood Policing Plan (NPP) pilot program. Working alongside colleagues with the Mayor's Office of Homeless Services (MOHS), community engagement staff also conducted a canvas and safety walk on North Avenue, successfully connecting 12 individuals who are experiencing homelessness with services and transitional housing supports.

In service of the community engagement work already underway in the Greenmount and 32nd community, MONSE also plans to maintain presence for residents and will be on-site to provide services and support on a weekly basis.

The following community engagement events are currently scheduled to occur in the coming weeks:

- MONSE and My Brother's Keeper will host a combined resource fair for local residents
- A healing celebration in the Brooklyn community in partnership with HABC, including a comprehensive resource area and space for residents to come together in a safe, nurturing environment known as the healing village.

### **Group Violence Reduction Strategy (GVRS)**

MONSE and the Mayor's Office of Employment Development (MOED) recently finalized a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) to support ongoing transitional employment supports for participants. Plans are also currently underway to finalize an MOU with the Baltimore City Department of Planning to make new opportunities available with the department's Clean Corps network, which seeks to connect participants with various local non-profits around improvement and maintenance of green space throughout the city. At the same time, GVRS is continuing to reduce homicides and non-fatal shootings in Baltimore, resulting in a city-wide 35% reduction in murders when compared to 2023.

### **Community Violence Intervention (CVI)**

MONSE and Safe Streets recently held kick-off events for the 4th annual Safe Summer program, with 444 attendees present. The central event was held in Druid Hill Park on May 25th, with additional activities scheduled at individual Safe Streets site throughout the week. Moving forward there will be weekly events held through September across all sites and in community as Safe Streets and MONSE again promote a summer of no-violence. Attendance of this year's kick-off showed a sizeable increase from 2023, which brought approximately 150 individuals out for celebration.

Safe Streets also hosted a rally for Safe Streets: the movement, with 94 individuals in attendance. Supporting events and activities included a household supplies giveaway, resources for children, food giveaways, medical service referrals, and public education material on Safe Streets. The rally began at the 2000 block of W. Baltimore Street, before moving west and culminating in an outdoor block party in Pigtown's Carroll Park.

Lastly, in May MONSE hosted its second CVI network meeting, with additional partners continuing to enlist and participate in the critical work of the CVI ecosystem. Notable additions include personnel from the city's HVIP network, including hospital responders and other medical staff.

### **Finance**

The following ARPA-funded agreements were approved by the Board of Estimates in May: Johns Hopkins HVIP contract (\$250,000); HARBEL (\$150,000); House of Ruth (\$100,000)

### ***Mayor's Office of Immigrant Affairs (MIMA)***

#### **Baltimore New Americans Access Coalition (BNAAC)**

BNAAC concluded enrollment of new clients on May 31, 2024 and enrolled 731 cases (667 family cases and 64 individual cases) in total at the end of the grant. Esperanza Center and SECDC exceeded their enrollment targets by 29 and 2 cases, respectively. CASA met their enrollment target of 215 cases. Global Refuge enrolled 30 cases during their 7-month operational period. To date, BNAAC has closed 427 cases. Global Refuge concluded their Employment Referral training series in May. SECDC reported successes in connecting clients with Medicaid, Office of Home Energy Programs (OHEP) and SNAP (new applications and redeterminations), noting best outcomes and quickest turn-around times. Additionally, access to primary care has been successful with referrals to Chase Brexton and Baltimore Medical System. Success is also noted with referrals to dental services with CareFirst and CCBC.

In the last month BNAAC Outreach occurred at a variety of community events and community meetings. These include MIMA hosted events like the Latino Immigrant Resource Fair in the Baltimore neighborhood Brooklyn. As well as tabling events at St. Fatima Cultural Day and the Fallstaff Health Fair. BNAAC outreach also occurred at community meetings like the 311 Baltimore Ambassador Meeting, the SEIU Union meeting, and the Student Family Council Meeting for Benjamin Franklin High. In the next month outreach for BNAAC will slow down as enrollment decreases. The BNAAC project will begin a qualitative analysis of the information and opinions of all program contributors. This will begin with interview question development and interviewing of the BNAAC teams.

#### **Language Access**

In May MIMA completed its initial meetings with City agencies in Cohort 3, for the purpose of initiating the language access planning process. On May 31, half of agencies in Cohort 3 had completed the agency survey for 4-factor analysis, a baseline assessment of the agency's current

language access services, protocols for providing language access, and the agency's encounters with Limited English Proficient (LEP) individuals in Baltimore City. MIMA received the remaining surveys from Cohort 3 in the first week of June. Completion of the agency survey is the pre-development phase for Cohort 3 Agencies. In June, MIMA will focus on supporting agencies to create a language access plan and identify vital documents for translation. In May, MIMA's SharePoint site, "Language Access Program" became viewable to all Baltimore city employees, which was previously only viewable by Agency Language Access Liaisons.

MIMA hosted its Language Access Oversight Committee meeting on May 29th, presenting updates and progress on MIMA's Language Access Project. MIMA also presented on the Language Access Program during the Baltimore Immigration Summit on May 31st.

## ***Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD)***

### **Park Heights Senior Housing and Multi-family**

As both the infrastructure and senior housing phases of Park Heights are underway, the third phase consisting of multi-family homes is in the grant agreement draft phase and should be executed mid-late Summer.

### **Impact Investment Areas**

The IIA project currently has 58 properties in Stage 5 (settlement) of acquisitions. There are 7 properties currently awaiting to be approved by the BOE.

### **Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design (CPTED)**

The CPTED project currently has 10 stabilizations in progress in the Fayette Street Outreach (FSO) neighborhood and 2 stabilizations for properties located in the Greater Baybrook Alliance (GBA) neighborhoods. There are also 4 demolitions planned for the GBA neighborhood.

## ***Department of Planning (DOP)***

### **Produce Boxes**

The Food Policy and Planning team will be additional funding to produce box sites by way of grants from the African American Mayors Association. Funding will be used to provide nutrition education and or support produce box distribution operations. To date the amount of Produce Box tonnage of fruits and vegetables served is approximately 993 tons (1,986,300 lbs).

### **Farm Incubator Program**

The Farm Alliance is partnering with the Maryland Food Bank to provide produce for their mobile market and food distribution programs. In addition, a partnership with the YMCA of Central Maryland this growing season is set to take place to further increase their reach. Produce grown at the farm incubator goes directly into the boxes that are distributed to residents in Healthy Food Priority Areas.

### **Online SNAP**

The Online SNAP team conducted 25 training and tabling events with community members, community-based organizations, and city government agencies.

The team provided training and educational materials on the following topics: Online SNAP and the B'more Fresh incentive program, digital equity, and food resources in Baltimore City. DOP also provided hands-on technical assistance to residents wanting to learn more about utilizing online nutrition incentives.

### **Produce Rx**

The Produce Rx program continues to enroll patients from MedStar Health Harbor Hospital and was happy to share the progress of a Patient:

*At time of enrollment in Food Rx program in January 2024, patient's A1c was >14.0, and she had accepted this as just the way things are for her -- "my diabetes have always been high." She was not checking her blood sugar because when she did, it was always high and she didn't understand why, which made her anxious. Over the past 5 months, patient has begun checking her blood glucose (BG), even if not as often as recommended. She has also started taking the same dose of her basal insulin at the same time every day and has noticed that she has more energy and just feels better overall. Her A1c on May 2, 2024 was down to 10.3. At her last appointment, patient brought in the food and BG log I have been encouraging her to complete for several months. We reviewed each meal, and with some prompting, patient was able to differentiate protein foods from carbs, and could tell whether the food items she ate would increase her blood glucose or not. She documented a few pre-and post-meal BG pairs, and patient was able to understand that higher carb meals make her BG go higher than lower carb meals. After making this connection, patient agreed to check BG more frequently.*

### **Nutrition Incentives at Farmers Markets**

The Maryland Market Money (MMM) participated in the annual vendor training for the Baltimore Farmers Market. They also plan to provide technical assistance to farmers and incentive customers. MMM is working with 32nd Street and Govans Markets to participate in the e-incentives pilot, a new e-incentive platform, Healthy Together will be launching in August 2024 and will include improved experiences for customers and farmers, and reduced overhead costs. The app will also be used for the Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program, which Baltimore City has the highest redemption rate in the state. MMM will also pilot the e-incentives program at Hollins Market on reopening.

### **Department of Planning (DOP)**

#### **Clean Corps**

No monthly report provided.

### **Department of General Services (DGS)**

#### **Baltimore Police Department (BPD) Fleet**

DGS has received 50 of the BPD Police Interceptor Utilities (PIUs) ordered using ARPA funds. The remaining 50 BPD PIUs are estimated to be delivered in September 2024. The 50 vehicles received to-date have all been upfitted and 38 are now in service.

#### **Department of Public Works (DPW) Load Packers**

DGS fleet has received all 20 ARPA-funded load packers. Ten units have been upfitted, tagged, and labeled and are now in service.

### **HVAC Improvements at City Libraries**

Design work is underway for the six library branches that will receive HVAC repair and replacement. At this time, DGS expects that construction at the Brooklyn and Northwood libraries will be completed first. Construction for all six libraries is expected to conclude by October 2025.

### **Capital Improvements**

Construction for the Northwest Community Action Center project is underway. DGS has placed signage at the Northwest Community Action Center informing the building users and visitors about the ongoing roof and storefront replacement project. Work is expected to be completed in September 2024.

DGS is currently working to procure a contract for the City Hall Roof project.

Two interagency agreements were executed with DGS to carry out facilities improvements at Baltimore City Fire Stations. These include roof replacements, bathroom renovations, and other facility upgrades. DGS has amended and procured all contracts to carry out these improvements. Construction is expected to start shortly. Roof replacements are slated to be completed by December 2024.

## ***Department of Public Works (DPW)***

### **Waste Removal**

DPW is utilizing \$3,285,000 in ARPA funding to cover a contract for Spindler Refuse Service, Inc. to provide residential trash and recycling hauling for one year to help return to weekly recycling services. The contract will end October 31, 2024.

### **Recycling Crews**

All thirty (30) ARPA funded recycling crew positions (10 solid waste drivers and 20 solid waste workers) were hired in January. These roles experience elevated turnover rates across the industry, a trend that similarly impacts DPW. As of May, one driver position reopened and DPW is actively engaged in efforts to fill this position promptly. All 30 positions will move to the general fund in FY25.

### **Capital and Operating Improvements**

DPW will utilize \$5,659,780 in ARPA funds for capital and operating improvements. Capital improvements include facility upgrades at various locations. Operating improvements include the purchase of new technology, as well as larger equipment including mini-load packers, tractors, and bobcats. DPW is currently working to amend existing contracts to include specific ARPA language.

## ***Baltimore City Fire Department (BCFD)***

In March, an agreement was signed with BCFD for \$4.7 million in ARPA funding for the strategic acquisitions of life-saving equipment, reinforcing safety standards for our firefighters, emergency medical services personnel, and the broader Baltimore community. The equipment includes self-contained breathing apparatuses, thermal imaging cameras, hose replacements, and rain hoods. In addition to the two capital projects for BCFD being overseen by DGS, the total amount committed to BCFD totals \$10M. BCFD is currently in the process of amending and procuring contracts for life-saving equipment.

## ***Department of Transportation (DOT)***

### **ADA Ramp Reconstruction**

With the Citywide contract Notice to Proceed (NTP) issued in April, the contractor began work on ADA ramp reconstruction, and next month's report will reflect this performance. BCDOT the East and West Job Order Contracts are on the June 26<sup>th</sup> BoE agenda, with the NTP scheduled 8 weeks after that.

### **Sidewalk Repair**

In its review of awards, BCDOT and SMBAD found that the 1<sup>st</sup> bidder for the sidewalk repair contract was noncompliant, and the 2<sup>nd</sup> bidder is almost double the advertised cost. This has delayed the award and NTP schedule for another month, as BCDOT is looking to readvertise this contract.

## ***Baltimore City Public School System (BCPSS)***

### **Northwestern High School (HS) Air Conditioning Installation**

BCPSS has issued purchase orders for air conditioning units, though work has not yet started. BCPSS expects work to be completed prior to the beginning of the Fall semester.

### **City Springs Replacement Building Design Services**

BCPSS is still in the process of drafting a Request for Proposal (RFP) for this work.

### **Edmondson High School (HS) Career & Technical Education (CTE) Renovations Design Services**

BCPSS is still in the process of drafting a Request for Proposal (RFP) for this work.

## **Performance Measures and Metrics**

A select number of performance measures are included in Table 3. Measures should not be viewed as underperforming since many programs or data collection are just beginning. The Recovery Office will continue to coordinate with subrecipients on measure accuracy. Additional data on performance measures will be included in Council reports as programs are further implemented, and data becomes available.
