## Background

This memorandum accompanies the City of Baltimore Mayor's Office of Recovery Program's submission of its monthly report to the City Council on spending and performance related to American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding. Specifically, Council Bill 21-0121 § 49-2(B) prescribes the elements of legislatively required reporting, which stipulates that monthly reports should:

- 1) Provide data and metrics regarding how the funds have:
  - I. Increased the effectiveness of city government services;
  - II. Broadened the reach of city government services;
  - III. Made city government services more efficient;
  - IV. Made city government services more sustainable
  
- 2) Identify key performance indicators, benchmarks, and targets related to:
  - I. Equity, as defined in Article 1, § 39-1 of the Baltimore City Code;
  - II. Population Growth;
  - III. Labor and Employment;
  - IV. Economic Growth, especially the growth of minority and women-owned businesses; and,
  - V. Community Benefit

## Commitments and Expenditures

At the end of April, the Mayor's Office of Recovery Programs has committed \$641.1 million in ARPA funds to City agencies, quasi-governmental organizations, and nonprofits to advance priority initiatives for the benefit of Baltimore City residents. Through April 2024, about \$255.7 million dollars has been spent on ARPA-funded projects (See Table 1), accounting for about 40% of the current commitments and of the city's \$641M total ARPA allocation.

## Commitments

Table 1 lists ARPA commitments totaling \$641,170,126, and expenditures total \$255,736,492 through April 2024.

## Recovery Office Accomplishments

The Mayor's Office of Recovery Programs directly awarded ARPA funding to 45 nonprofit organizations. As of April 2024, all 45 nonprofits have received disbursements totaling \$27.8 million. See Table 1 for total disbursements. In addition, some highlights of select nonprofit activities in April are as follows:

- FreeState Justice's resource program developed new partnerships with House of Ruth and Turnaround Inc. Expanding LGBTQ+ intimate partner violence training in collaboration with House of Ruth is an important step in increasing awareness and providing resources to support victims of intimate partner violence in the LGBTQ+ community.
- During April, Greater Baltimore Urban League celebrated several noteworthy achievements including assisting two justice-impacted individuals with securing stable employment, enrolling one participant in the GED program at Baltimore City Community College, and assisting another justice-impacted individual in finding employment and enrolling in driving school.
- ReBUILD Metro has now completed stabilization construction of all 15 Teachers Square properties, including the finalization of structural repairs on exterior walls of several of the properties from 600-618 East Biddle.

In addition, the Recovery Office continues to provide technical assistance to all funded city agencies, quasi government agencies and nonprofits as well as coordinating with centralized functions such as legal, procurement and finance to facilitate timely disbursements and expenditures.

## Subawardee Accomplishments

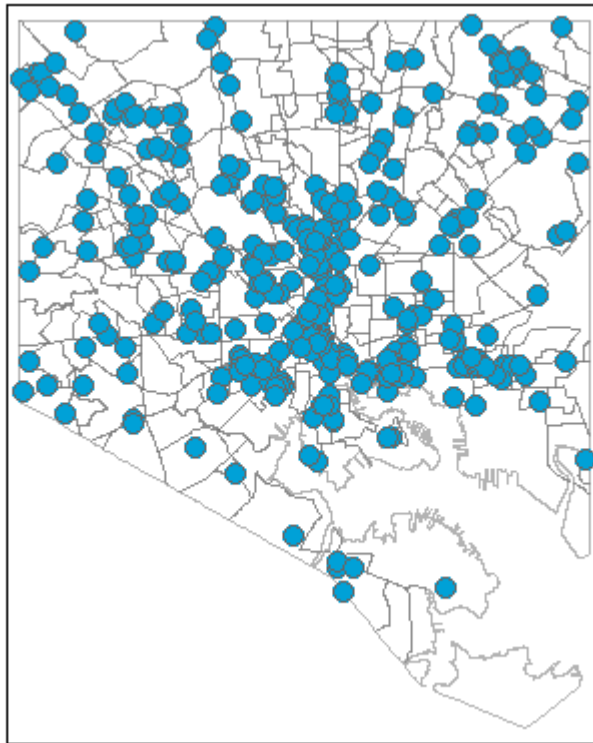
### *Economic Recovery Fund*

There have been 1,067 grants awarded, totaling \$19,895,845, from Economic Recovery Fund fiscal agents to beneficiaries, including nonprofits and small businesses (See Appendix for a complete list of organizations). Four out of five fiscal agents have completely disbursed grant



funds. The fifth fiscal agent—Baltimore Development Corporation (BDC)—continues to disburse grants to its subrecipients. The map below indicates the location of all organizations funded by BDC through April 2024. ### ***Baltimore Development Corporation (BDC) Economic Recovery Assistance***

BDC processed a limited number of second round checks – totaling 17 checks (2 second checks to Round 1 awardees and 15 second checks to Round 2 awardees). BDC continues to coordinate with businesses in Round 2 to gather and authenticate the necessary documentation to issue checks. BDC is also coordinating with businesses on eligible uses of grant funding, as some businesses' needs have changed since submitting their application for funding. BDC is also in the process of coordinating with the Recovery Office to review expenditures, budgets, and performance of the Technical Assistance (TA) partners in the BASE Network. All payments to small businesses and TA partners should be complete by June 2024.

## **City Agency Accomplishments**

### ***Baltimore City Recreation and Parks (BCRP)***

The Towanda and Coldstream Pool reconstruction projects, which were bid together as one project, were awarded at the Board of Estimates on April 17th. The Greater Model Pool project is at 98% design completion, and is being prepared to be bid in June.

Four Playgrounds have started construction: Luzerne and Biddle, Elmley, Bonview, and Patterson Park – Linwood Ave. Playground projects take roughly 4-6 weeks to complete construction.

BCRP also successfully increased the contract limits for one playground contractor and the athletic court resurfacing contract, which will allow them to complete all playground and athletic court projects in calendar year 2024.

Due to questions from bidders, the bid due date for the Gwynns Falls Trail signage project was changed to May 15<sup>th</sup>.

## **Baltimore City Health Department (BCHD)**

### **Vulnerable Communities/Adult Guardianship**

Two new case managers were onboarded, which fills all five case manager positions. BCHD is still in the process of recruiting for the social worker position.

### **Food insecurity**

Highlights of this project are as follows:

- **Meals and Food Boxes:** Meals for older adults continues to have high participation. The Baltimore City Maryland Access Point (MAP) call center has received an uptick in calls requesting food. Typically, daily call volumes are 120-130 calls, but has recently increased to 150-160 with these additional calls primarily requesting food resources.
- **City of Refuge:** City of Refuge is providing meals and a food pantry for residents in the Brooklyn and Curtis Bay communities. They continue to provide food resources to the Spanish speaking community and have been providing meals for the Comiendo Juntos program located in Assisi House in East Baltimore.
- **SNAP Outreach:** BCHD's Baltimore Corps Fellows are working closely with Maryland Food Bank and the Department of Planning to provide SNAP outreach and assistance. The Fellows attend senior centers with Maryland Food Bank to help center members apply for SNAP and provide clarity around SNAP benefits. Additionally, the team is working closely with the Department of Planning and the Virtual Supermarket to target older adults to participate in the Bmore Fresh program. Fellows are helping older adults understand the benefits of SNAP and navigate the platforms to make online grocery purchases. BCHD plans to continue with additional outreach efforts at senior centers in the coming months.

### **Vaccination**

BCHD partners held 35 vaccination clinics in April and administered 435 doses.

Twenty-eight VALUE communities' engagement events were held in the month of April to promote COVID-19 vaccination. These engagement efforts occur at various community events including at schools, senior centers, food distribution sites, and health/resource fairs. Additional VALUE communities events are scheduled for the month of May.

### **Testing**

BCHD worked with the Bureau of Procurement to submit a COVID-19 test kit procurement contract to the BOE for a May approval.

## **Baltimore City Information & Technology (BCIT)**

### **Hardware Refresh, CitiWwatch, and Hybrid Meeting Rooms**

BCIT has met the target of replacing 185 Citiwatch cameras and is currently at an 80% completion percentage in configuring City conference rooms into hybrid meeting rooms.

BCIT is awaiting the return of bids for the PC Hardware solicitation, which will replace the City's existing contract for laptops and desktops. BCIT is also amending its professional services agreement to update rates for ongoing maintenance and support services.

### **Tax System Modernization Software**

The Board of Estimates approved a contract to procure licenses for their revX software for \$4M, which includes a 3 year subscription to the revX Revenue and Property Software. The software is part of a larger tax system modernization effort between BCIT and the Department of Finance.

### **Broadband and Digital Equity (BDE)**

#### *Public Wi-Fi Initiative*

The Board of Estimates approved a contract for the installation, maintenance, and repairs of wireless access points. This contract will help facilitate the expedited deployment of wireless access points, which will provide increased wireless coverage and connectivity.

#### *Digital Skills*

Since September 2023, BCIT-BDE has made significant progress in providing digital skills training and wellness services to older adults across various locations. A total of 256 older adults have participated in digital skills training. In addition, 506 older adults have received wellness (telehealth education and health screenings) services.

#### *Chromebook Distribution*

This initiative continues to see success, with 3,373 devices distributed in April 2024, bringing the total number of devices distributed to 22,057.

#### *Employee Digital Skills*

For employee digital skills training, BCIT-BDE has hosted 91 attendees to-date. Specific agency training sessions are scheduled throughout May and June 2024, with enrollments ranging from 25 to 140 employees per session.

#### *Community Meetings*

During the month of April 2024, several community engagement initiatives were undertaken to demonstrate commitment to promoting social welfare and community development.

On April 9, 2024, a virtual community meeting was held with a total of 23 attendees. The meeting focused on important topics such as the Digital Equity Fund (DEF), distribution of Chromebooks, and updates on legislative matters. The active participation of all attendees showed their collective dedication in keeping up with technological progress and policy changes that affect the community.

On April 11, 2024, BCIT-BDE attended and provided resources at a Town Hall event for Older Adults in District 10. Town Halls allow residents to learn about available services and future plans while raising issues of concern. The initiative demonstrated a commitment to inclusivity and equitable access to resources. It provided a forum for residents to express their concerns and to engage with elected officials, community leaders, and other stakeholders.

Throughout April 2024, the Digital Inclusion Advisory Board held multiple meetings, including both individual and group sessions. In total, 11 participants actively contributed to discussions

focused on improving digital inclusion strategies. These meetings provided a platform for brainstorming creative solutions and promoting cooperation among partners.

BCIT-BDE attended Mayor Scott's event for Older Adults on April 29, 2024. The event showcased the city's commitment to its older residents, encouraged community cohesion, and addressed the unique concerns of the elderly population. The event was a great platform for the older residents of the city to come together and share their experiences.

### ***Mayor's Office of Homeless Services (MOHS)***

#### **Shelter Demobilization**

The Board of Estimates has approved agreements to fund housing for at-risk youth and the Housing Authority of Baltimore City (HABC) to renovate and set-aside HABC units for permanent supportive housing (PSH).

#### **Housing Accelerator Fund**

Nearly \$15 million in ARPA Housing Accelerator Fund grants were announced in spring 2024. These are grants for experienced developers with plans to create permanent supportive housing (PSH) units. MOHS is working closely with DHCD for this portion of the grant program. Grant agreements are currently being drafted for review and approval by all parties. Agreements will be submitted to the Board of Estimates for approval in summer 2024.

Nearly \$1 million of this fund is allocated to the Supportive Housing Institute, which is designed to provide intensive capacity building, training, and technical assistance to emerging developers. After they complete the Institute's trainings, the five emerging developers will be eligible to apply for funding for pre-development activities. The Institute will end in May 2024 and the five emerging developer teams will prepare to apply for funding in June 2024.

#### **Communications and Community Engagement**

MOHS updated the ARPA website, created an annual report and published its first monthly newsletter—which will highlight ARPA Initiatives and provide current updates and information, and the work with Landlords and Rapid Rehousing. MOHS also conducts monthly outreach to the Providers, and the Coordinated Access staff is working in collaboration with United Way and Housing Navigators, across Baltimore City, to ensure that the Flex Fund is being used to reduce evictions and rapidly resolve homelessness. Finally, MOHS works closely with the Continuum of Care and is currently in the process of engaging advocates and the community to participate in the development of PSH standards.

### ***Mayor's Office of Neighborhood Safety and Engagement (MONSE)***

#### **Policy and Research**

The Criminal Justice Coordinating Council (CJCC) held its bimonthly meeting April 11 with representation from the State's Attorney's Office (SAO), Parole and Probation, the Department of Juvenile Services (DJS), the Governor's Office of Crime Prevention and Policy (GOCPP), and BPD. The agenda included productive discussions on auto thefts and home monitoring, which identified cross-agency coordination barriers and opportunities in each area. The Domestic Violence Coordinating Council (DVCC) met on April 25 and the workgroup has set priorities for the 2025 fiscal year. The warrants workgroup is on track to help implement a process for prioritizing service of the highest risk warrants citywide. A new workgroup focusing on community justice was recently formed and is developing actionable goals around auto theft diversion.

#### **Victim Services**

MONSE strengthened its partnership with the Mayor's Office of Children and Family Success to

pour more efforts into school based victimizations, including served several recent/ high profile cases in the last 4 months that have been referred over from City schools.

Regarding Intimate Partner Violence (IPV), The Gateway Project at the House of Ruth is continuing their programmatic efforts to deliver workshops for those who cause harm and providing a fee waiver for those with an inability to pay, thereby increasing their likelihood of completing the program by removing the barrier of associated costs. This model (no fee-for-services model) has become a best practice adopted by the Governor's Office.

The MONSE Victim Services team will host a Latin Resource fair in June. This event is based on the continued efforts MONSE has exhibited related to the Brooklyn Homes Mass shooting incident. Victim's Services has extended their partnership with a number of Latinx Consulates to better provide resources to the local Latinx community. These Consulates will join MONSE in upcoming events, fairs and community outreach to help reduce recidivism and violence. Turn Around has been actively engaged in workshops with youth at Nexus Woodbourne and Boys Hope Girls Hope and have increased the level of trusted engagements resulting in a higher level of vulnerability and sharing within the identified cohort groups as the project continues. Additionally, Turn Around has launched workshops, in partnership with DJS, for youth in detention.

### **Community Safety and Response**

Following the Mondawmin Mall shooting of a 7 year-old, MONSE Coordinated Neighborhood Stabilization Response (CNSR) and Side Step Lanes have stabilized the Mall area focusing on reducing violence amongst school aged teens. Before stabilization, MTA Police had advised MONSE that there were an average of 3-5 physical fights on Fridays outside the Mall. Since stabilization, there have been zero reported verbal or physical fights when MONSE is present.

The Re-entry bill was signed on April 2, 2024. In the last meeting of Behind the Wall on April 18, 2024, MONSE provided case management services with the following agencies: MOED, Future Inspirations, and New Vision House of Hope.

### ***Mayor's Office of Immigrant Affairs (MIMA)***

#### **Baltimore New American Access Coalition (BNAAC)**

Overall, BNAAC projects to enroll 741 cases in total, comprised of 65 individual cases and 676 families. This increase from the totals shared last month is the result of one Community-Based Organization (CBO) exceeding their enrollment target by 31 cases. MD Hunger Solutions provided Benefit Navigators (BN) with a training for emergency SNAP benefits. Global Refuge provided a training for the Migration Mental Health Program focusing on mental health support for Spanish speaking Latino immigrants. Global Refuge provided a training for case re-engagement/reopening procedures, case closure and budget demonstration refreshers. Global Refuge also hosted another best practices session with BNs.

In the past month BNAAC outreach has occurred at a resource fair in Morrel Park and at Baybrook Elementary School, a presentation at a family meeting at Charles Carol Barrister, tabling at a Curtis Bay food distribution and a food distribution in Park heights, tabling at a community fair at Lakeland Rec and STEAM Center. In the next month, BNAAC outreach will include tabling at BenFest a community fair at Benjamin Franklin Highschool, a community resource fair at Fallstaff EMS, Dia del Nino at Patterson Park, a BNAAC co-sponsored Resource Fair in Brooklyn as well as family BNAAC presentations at St. Vincent DePaul HeadStart and Curtis Bay and Cherry Hill Judy Centers.

#### **Language Access**

The new ARPA Language Access Project Manager was onboarded to the MIMA team. Additionally, the team conducted briefing sessions with agency directors on the CAO's

language access directive and policy. The briefings have helped establish a foundation for moving forward with collaboration to create language access guidance documents. Between April 22 and April 30, MIMA held several meetings with a new cohort of City agencies, to initiate the language access planning process, on-board language access liaisons, and provide an orientation to the language access planning tools, resources, and materials that MIMA developed for City agencies.

MIMA is preparing to present at the Baltimore Immigration Summit and will host its next Language Access Oversight Committee at the end of May.

## ***Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD)***

### **Permitting System Upgrades**

DHCD has completed review of the BMZA electronic appeal process integration. The prototype has been built and is in the validation process. The target to go live for the complete permitting system remains December 2024.

### **Impact Investment Areas**

DHCD will partner with Rebuild Metro to complete a large stabilization project for 508 E. Preston Street and Black Women Build for the stabilization of multiple properties on Sarah Ann Street in the upcoming months.

### **Renter's Right to Counsel**

In partnership with Maryland Legal Aid, the Renter's Right to Counsel which focuses on providing legal consultation pro bono for renters facing eviction has been able to close approximately 650 cases and assisted more than 1,000 family members in eviction prevention.

### **Uplands Redevelopment**

The Uplands Redevelopment has completed approximately 90% of the infrastructure phase of the project. The completion of the rental units is expected to be completed by the end of this calendar year.

### **HUBS**

DHCD will be partnering with the following organizations to assist in servicing housing upgrades for seniors:

DHCD plans to execute the agreements with partners organizations in the Summer.

## ***Department of Planning (DOP)***

### **Clean Corps**

DOP will be expanding the Clean Corps neighborhood footprint to the following neighborhoods:

- Edgewood
- Johnston Square

- Madison-Eastend
- Mid-Town Edmonson
- Milton Montford
- Mondawmin
- Mosher
- New/Southwest Mount Clare
- Oliver
- Parview/Woodbrook
- Rosemont
- Winchester
- South Clifton Park

The additional neighborhoods will be serviced by the addition of three regional crews who will rotate on a weekly basis throughout these neighborhoods.

### **Food Insecurity**

#### *Farmers Market*

The market season started in mid-April and the e-incentive pilot launched at the Baltimore Farmer's Market this season, which is the City's largest market. It also may be launched at 32nd Street Market later this year.

#### *Online SNAP*

DOP's Online SNAP program consultant developed a 2023 impact and reach evaluation report. This report provides an overview of 2023 data that highlights overall program reach and impact for B'more Fresh participants. This report will be shared with external stakeholders, partners, and residents at the end of May.

#### *Produce Box Distribution*

DOP has completed site visits and met with all 32 sites points of contacts. The team is working on turning this feedback into a report about the produce box distribution program. All site points of contact expressed positive feedback about Common Market logistics and the produce quality. DOP also gained insight into what box recipients would like to see in the boxes in the future.

## **Department of General Services (DGS)**

### **Baltimore Police Department (BPD) Fleet**

DGS has received 50 of the BPD Police Interceptor Utilities (PIUs) ordered using ARPA funds. The remaining 50 BPD PIUs are estimated to be delivered in September 2024. The 50 vehicles received to-date have all been upfitted and 28 are now in service.

### **Department of Public Works (DPW) Load Packers**

DGS fleet has received 19 ARPA-funded load packers. Ten units have been upfitted, tagged, and labeled and are now in service.

### **HVAC Improvements at City Libraries**

DGS and Rife International have finalized the overall design-build cost for the six (6) libraries that are part of the Enoch Pratt Free HVAC Repair Project. The contract was approved at the March 6th BOE meeting and the notice to proceed was issued for April 17, 2024. Work is expected to be completed at all six locations by October 2025.

## **Capital Improvements**

The pre-construction meeting for the Northwest Community Action Center project was held on March 26, 2024. The notice to proceed was issued for April 15, 2024. In the next 1-2 months, DGS will be placing signage at the Northwest Community Action Center that will inform the building users and visitors about the ongoing roof and storefront replacement project.

The City Hall Roof project was advertised for bid on January 26, 2024, and all bids were received by March 6, 2024, and are currently under review.

In March, two interagency agreements were executed with DGS to carry out facilities improvements at Baltimore City Fire Stations. These include roof replacements, bathroom renovations, and other facility upgrades. DGS is currently amending and procuring contracts to carry out these improvements.

## **Department of Public Works (DPW)**

### **Waste Removal**

DPW is utilizing \$3,285,000 in ARPA funding to cover a contract for Spindler Refuse Service, Inc. to provide residential trash and recycling hauling for one year to help return to weekly recycling services. The contract will end October 31, 2024.

### **Recycling Crews**

All thirty (30) ARPA funded recycling crew positions (10 solid waste drivers and 20 solid waste workers) were hired in January. These roles experience elevated turnover rates across the industry, a trend that similarly impacts DPW. As of April, three driver positions reopened and DPW is actively engaged in efforts to fill these positions promptly.

### **Capital and Operating Improvements**

DPW will utilize \$5,659,780 in ARPA funds for capital and operating improvements. Capital improvements include facility upgrades at various locations. Operating improvements include the purchase of new technology, as well as larger equipment including mini-load packers, tractors, and bobcats. DPW is currently working to amend existing contracts to include specific ARPA language.

## **Baltimore City Fire Department (BCFD)**

In March, an agreement was signed with BCFD for \$4.7 million in ARPA funding for the strategic acquisitions of life-saving equipment, reinforcing safety standards for our firefighters, emergency medical services personnel, and the broader Baltimore community. The equipment includes self-contained breathing apparatuses, thermal imaging cameras, hose replacements, and rain hoods. In addition to the two capital projects for BCFD being overseen by DGS, the total amount committed to BCFD totals \$10M. BCFD is currently in the process of amending and procuring contracts for life-saving equipment.

## **Department of Transportation (DOT)**

DOT signed an interagency grant agreement with the Recovery Office on April 18th for \$13,100,000 to reconstruct 1,300 sidewalk ramps and replace 61,000 square feet of sidewalks in Baltimore City. Funding is also included for construction inspection services.

### **ADA Ramp Reconstruction**



The budget includes three Job Order Contracts (JOCs). BCDOT issued a Notice to Proceed (NTP) for the Citywide contract. Due to bid extensions and one bid protest, award dates for the East and West contracts were delayed to June 2 and July 10, respectively, with targeted NTPs in July and August 2024, respectively.

**Sidewalk Repair**

The contract for sidewalk repairs is still in the award phase. DOT is targeting a June 26 award date and hopes to issue an NTP in July 2024.

**Baltimore City Public School System (BCPSS)**

The BOE approved a grant agreement between the Recovery Office and BCPSS on March 27 for Capital Design Services and Renovations for \$8,189,820 funding four projects, outlined below. The projects will be completed by the end of December 2024.

**Northwestern High School (HS) Air Conditioning Installation**

BCPSS will install Air Conditioning (AC) units in 128 classrooms, the cafeteria, and the library at Northwestern HS. Purchase orders are expected to be issued for the first construction phase in May 2024.

**Mergenthaler Vocational-Technical (MerVo) High School (HS) Football Field Replacement.**

BCPSS will replace the football field at MerVo HS with a synthetic turf football field. BCPSS is in the process of soliciting an updated proposal for an on-call vendor to execute this work.

**City Springs Replacement Building Design Services**

BCPSS is currently drafting a Request for Proposal (RFP) for this work.

**Edmondson High School (HS) Career & Technical Education (CTE) Renovations Design Services**

BCPSS is currently drafting a Request for Proposal (RFP) for this work.

**Performance Measures and Metrics**

A select number of performance measures are included in Table 3. Measures should not be viewed as underperforming since many programs or data collection are just beginning. The Recovery Office will continue to coordinate with subrecipients on measure accuracy. Additional data on performance measures will be included in Council reports as programs are further implemented, and data becomes available.
